

**RESOLUTION NO.21-006**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE OF THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF TEXAS UNDER THE RIFLE RESISTANT BODY ARMOR PROJECT; COMMITTING TO PROVIDING MATCHING FUNDS; DESIGNATION OF AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR OPEN MEETINGS AND EFFECTIVE DATE CLAUSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Marlin, Texas finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Marlin that the Rifle Resistant Body Armor Project (Project) be operated for the 2021-2022 fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Marlin, Texas agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the BG-Rifle Resistant Body Armor Grant Program grant application; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Marlin, Texas agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Marlin, Texas designates Chief of Police James Hommel as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS, that:**

**Section 1. Findings.** The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

**Section 2. City Council Approval.** The City Council for the City of Marlin, Texas approves submission of the grant application for the Rifle Resistant Body Armor Project to the Office of the Governor.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective from and after the date of its passage in accordance with the Texas Local Gov.'t Code and the City Charter.

**Section 4. Open Meetings.** That the City Council has found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is considered is open to the public and that notice thereof was given in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, as amended, and that a quorum of the City Council was present.
