

RESOLUTION NO. 21012

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPOINTING THE FALLS COUNTY TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR TO CALCULATE THE EFFECTIVE TAX RATE FOR THE CITY OF MARLIN TEXAS; AND PROVIDING FOR OPEN MEETINGS AND EFFECTIVE DATE CLAUSES.

WHEREAS, in accordance with state law, the City of Marlin, Texas is required to adopt a tax rate for the 2021-2022 tax year;

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Marlin finds that it is the best interest of the City and the citizens of the City of Marlin that the City Council appoint the Falls County Tax Assessor – Collector to calculate the effective tax rate for the City of Marlin for the 2021-2022 tax year; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS, that:

Section 1. Findings. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.


Section 2. City Council Approval. The City Council appoints Kayci Nehring, the Falls County Tax Assessor – Collector, to calculate the effective tax rate for the City of Marlin for the 2021-2022 tax year.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective from and after the date of its passage in accordance with the Texas Local Gov't. Code and the City Charter.


