Hommel said that they do have video of 3 suspects. There is an ordinance in place. He

packages not be left on porches. There are Amazon boxes outside of the store here in
town. Questions were asked about Racial Profiling Reports (council was provided a
copy) chief said he could provide a copy to the council at the regular meetings.

Environmental Document-Blanton and Associates are in the process with the USACE.

Drainage projects 1-7 were reviewed

The Bidding process was reviewed, sample documents shown, and the pond project explained. The funding for the pond project is separated form the rest of the project and it will be a different bid process. It will be a year before this project starts but other projects will be working. Once the projects start MRB will be overseeing them. Contractors will be doing door hangers to let residents know when they will be in their area.
