

RESOLUTION NO. 22-019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROPOSED TAX RATE FOR THE 2022-2023 TAX YEAR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Marlin ("City Council") is required to consider and adopt a proposed tax rate and then to approve the levy of taxes to fund the operation of the City for the 2022-2023 tax year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council must provide notice to the public of the proposed tax rate and under certain circumstances must conduct a public hearing on the proposed tax rate prior to the adoption of a tax rate, therefore, the City Council must first approve a proposed tax rate in order to provide any public notices as required by the Texas Tax Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. Approval of the Proposed Tax Rate of the 2022-2023 Tax Year. The City Council approves of the following proposed tax rate of \$ 0.81846 /\$100 valuation. This proposed tax rate will be the proposed maximum tax rate that the City Council may adopt for the purpose of making its tax levy for the 2022-2023 tax year. The City Council may adopt a lower tax rate for the purposes of making its tax levy for the 2022-2023 tax year than the proposed tax rate specified in this Section.

Section 2. Record Vote. The vote on the proposed tax rate is a record vote with the members of City Council voting as follows:

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective from and after the date of its passage in accordance with the Texas Local Gov't. Code.


