

RESOLUTION NO. 023-010

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICE PROVIDER(S) CONTRACTS FOR THE 2023-2024 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (TxCDBG) FUND; PROVIDING FOR OPEN MEETINGS AND EFFECTIVE DATE CLAUSES.

WHEREAS, the 2023-2024 Community Development Block Grant TxCDBG Community Development Fund contract requires implementation by professionals experienced in federally-funded community development projects;

WHEREAS, in order to identify qualified and responsive providers for these services a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) process for engineering/architectural/surveying services and has been completed in accordance with Texas CDBG requirements;

WHEREAS, the statement of qualifications received by the due date have been reviewed to determine the most qualified and responsive providers for each professional service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS, that:

Section 1. That Mundo & Associates, Inc. be awarded a contract to provide TxCDBG application and project-related **professional' engineering/architectural/surveying services** for the 2023-2024 Community Development Block Grant Texas Community Development Fund project.


Section 2. That any and all contracts or commitments made with the above-named services providers are dependent on the successful negotiation of a contract with the service provider.


Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Tex. Loc. Gov't. Code.
