

CITY OF MEBANE INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS:

The following inspections are required at various stages of construction for Single Family, Duplex and Townhomes.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER/CONTRACTOR TO CONTACT THIS DEPARTMENT FOR INSPECTIONS.

INSPECTIONS ARE REQUIRED TO BE CALLED IN BY 4:00 THE DAY BEFORE THE INSPECTION IS REQUESTED.

- 1. Footing inspection
- 2. Under slab inspection, as appropriate
- 3. Foundation inspection
- 4. Rough-in inspection
- 5. Building framing inspection
- 6. Insulation inspection
- 7. Fire protection inspection; and
- 8. Final inspection

You are reminded the N.C State Building Codes states that a Certificate of Occupancy is required on new construction. The Certification will only be issued after all final inspections are approved, required information is supplied and paperwork is complete.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER/CONTRACTOR TO ENSURE ALL STATE/LOCAL CODES ARE MET AND ENSURE ALL DOCUMENTATION IS PROVIDED TO THE INSPECTION DEPARTMENT.
