Jesse Whitaker, Chair of the Recreation and Parks Advocacy Commission (RPAC), called the joint meeting to order and welcomed the BPAC. The purpose of the meeting was to kick off engagement for the Recreation and Parks Comprehensive Master Plan and Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation Plan.

Additionally, the RPAC and BPAC participated in mapping exercises and discussed strategies to promote the engagement opportunities related to the two plans.

Following the joint activities, the BPAC met separately to briefly discuss a possible bike rodeo during AutumnFest on Saturday, October 1. The BPAC agreed on AO first checking with AD to see if space would be available at the Farmers Market location. If no space is available, the BPAC agreed to consider hosting the bike rodeo on a different weekend.
