Thank you for being a GFL Environmental customer! We wanted to provide you with an annual collection schedule for the 2024 year. The calendar below is marked with your area's collection dates. You'll notice that if your collection falls on a holiday, pickup will occur on the following day.

We would also like to reassure you that the safety of our customers, their families, and our employees remains our number one priority. In the event of inclement weather, your schedule may be altered. Please visit us online to track inclement weather alerts.

## The Following Holidays Could Affect Your Service Date:

• January 1st - New Year's Day • November 28th - Thanksgiving Day • December 25th - Christmas Day

\*Place recyclables at the curb the night before your collection day. Place bins at least 5 feet from garbage containers. Put recyclables in your recycle bin only. We cannot collect any extra recyclables outside the recyclable container.
