July 19, 2022

Mayor Collins gave the invocation and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council met in Regular Session at 6:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mayor Collins, Councilmembers: Colvin, McCabe, Nestor, Nicholas, Stalder, Thacker, and Thompson.

Motion was made by Colvin, seconded by Nestor to accept the minutes of the Regular Session on June 21, 2022, and Special Session on June 27, 2022, as distributed. Motion carried.

Mayor Collins opened the Citizen Forum and asked anyone present who wished to discuss an item not appearing on the agenda to come forward. There was no response, and the Forum was closed.

Police Chief John Sedlak introduced Alison Landrum, Administrative Assistant and Police Officers Matt Kash and Dylan Branham. The Mayor administered the oath of office.

Leslie Kohli presented Ordinance 6978. Ms. Kohli stated that this Ordinance is for Workers Compensation Insurance renewal with Group Retro. With this renewal BWC will provide a 2% early payment discount, go green rebate and target refund of \$46,239. The 2023 premium is \$110,092. Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 6978

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO ASSOCIATION OF PUBLIC TREASURERS (OAPT) WORKERS' COMPENSATION GROUP RETROSPECTIVE RATING PROGRAM FOR THE POLICY YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2023 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Motion was made by Colvin, seconded by Nicholas to dispense with the requirement that Ordinance No. 6978 be read on two separate days, authorize its adoption on the first reading and have it read by title only. Motion carried. The Ordinance was read by title only. Motion was made by Nicholas, seconded by Stalder to pass Ordinance No. 6978 carried by Yea Votes of Colvin, McCabe, Nestor, Nicholas, Stalder, Thacker, and Thompson.

Steve Schultz requested that the City Manager advertise and receive bids for the Evans Avenue and Genetta Drive Sanitary Sewer Replacement Project. Total cost \$440,000. Construction to beg in November 2022 and completed within six months.

Motion was made Thompson, seconded by Colvin to authorize the City Manager to advertise and receive bids for the Evans Avenue and Genetta Drive Sanitary Sewer

Replacement Project, carried by Yea Votes of Colvin, McCabe, Nestor, Nicholas, Stalder, Thacker, and Thompson.

Kevin McKinney asked Council to approve road closures for River Blast to be held on September 3, 2022.

Motion was made by Thompson, seconded by Thacker to approve the road closures for River Blast, carried by Yea Votes of Colvin, McCabe, Nestor, Nicholas, Stalder, Thacker, and Thompson.

Kevin McKinney asked Council for authorization to sign the F2 Temporary Alcohol Permit for River Blast to serve alcohol in Riverfront Park in a designated area. The DORA is also in effect for Riverfront Park


Motion was made by McCabe, seconded by Colvin to authorize the City Manager to complete the Owner's Acknowledgement within the River Blast, Miamisburg Community Foundation F2 Temporary Alcohol Permit, carried by Yea Votes of Colvin, McCabe, Nestor, Nicholas, Stalder, Thacker, and Thompson.


Motion was made by Nicholas, seconded by Stalder to recess to an executive session to discuss a litigation case and employee compensation. Motion carried by Yea Votes of Colvin, McCabe, Nestor, Nicholas, Stalder, Thacker, and Thompson.
