April 18, 2023

Mayor Collins gave the invocation and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council met in Regular Session at 6:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mayor Collins, Councilmembers: Colvin, McCabe, Nestor, Nicholas and Stalder.

Motion was made by Nicholas, seconded by Stalder to excuse Councilmembers Beachler and Thacker. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Colvin, seconded by Nestor to accept the minutes of the Regular Session on April 4, 2023 as distributed. Motion carried.

Mayor Collins opened the Citizen Forum and asked anyone present who wished to discuss an item not appearing on the agenda to come forward. There was no response, and the Forum was closed.

Bob Stanley presented Ordinance 7022. Mr. Stanley stated that three bids were received on April 3 for the 2023 Pavement Marking Program. Star Safety, LLC submitted the lowest and best bid of \$80,398.91. A&A Safety submitted a bid of \$93,539.27. The Aero-Mark Company submitted a bid of \$94,952.99. Funding for this project was approved in the 2023 capital improvement plan. Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.

## ORDINANCE NO. 7022

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE 2023 PAVEMENT MARKING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Motion was made by McCabe, seconded by Nicholas to dispense with the requirement that Ordinance No. 7022 be read on two separate days, authorize its adoption on the first reading and have it read by title only. Motion carried. The Ordinance was read by title only. Motion was made by Stalder, seconded by Colvin to pass Ordinance No. 7022, carried by Yea Votes of Colvin, McCabe, Nestor, Nicholas and Stalder.

Jennifer Johns presented Ordinance 7023. Ms. Johns stated that the Municipal Court received a grant in 2022 from the Ohio Supreme Court to pay a portion of the new court software. These funds were not included in the 2023 budget, but the funds are now available to be appropriated.
