Currently, 60.4% of the 313,054 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 35.9%, renter occupied; and 3.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 293,933 housing units in the area - 61.9% owner occupied, 33.7% renter occupied, and 4.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.84%. Median home value in the area is \$531,761, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.24% annually to \$594,156.
