



City of Montclair Emergency Directive No. 03

SUBJECT: EMERGENCY DIRECTIVE TO IMMEDIATELY SUSPEND ALL OUTDOOR AND INDOOR SWAP MEET EVENTS AT MISSION TIKI DRIVE-IN THEATRE, 10798 RAMONA AVENUE, MONTCLAIR, CA 91763

On Monday, March 16, 2020, the Montclair City Council adopted Resolution No. 20-3263 declaring a local public health emergency in the City of Montclair in relation to the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

In declaring a local public health emergency, the City Council invoked Section 6.080.060 of Chapter 6.08 of Title 6 of the Montclair Municipal Code providing that the City Manager, as Director of Emergency Services, is empowered to "*make and issue rules and regulations on matters reasonably related to the protection of life and property as affected by such emergency.*"

By virtue of authority vested in me as Director of Emergency Services, pursuant to Section 6.080.060 of Chapter 6.08 of Title 6 of the Montclair Municipal Code, and to preserve community health and avoid panic and other potential forms of civil unrest, I hereby declare and order the following to be necessary for the protection of life and property in the City of Montclair:

1. Outdoor and/or Indoor swap meet events at the Mission Tiki Drive-In Theatre represent a violation of Gathering Guidance and social distancing provisions issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), California Department of Public Health, and San Bernardino County Health Department. Accordingly, and until further notice, management/ownership of the Mission Tiki Drive-In Theater is directed to immediately suspend any and all outdoor and indoor swap meet event activities at the Mission Tiki Drive-In Theatre, located at 10798 Ramona Avenue, Montclair, CA 91763.
2. This Emergency Directive *shall not* be interpreted to order the suspension of the screening of movie events at the Mission Tiki Drive-In Theatre, provided that Gathering Guidance and social distancing practices are in place between customer vehicles and concession stand operations at the Mission Tiki Drive-In Theatre. *Management/ownership of the Mission Tiki Drive-In Theatre is advised; however, that an order to suspend the screening of movie events may be issued if the Director of Emergency Services determines that, in the interest of community health and the protection of life and property, such directive is warranted.*
3. Management/ownership of the Mission Tiki Drive-In Theatre shall implement provisions of Emergency Directive No. 03 immediately.
4. Provisions of Emergency Directive No. 03 shall remain in effect until rescinded.
