

**ORDINANCE NO. 2 , 2019**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PORTIONS OF CHAPTER 97, *PARKS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES***

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 97 of the Code of Ordinances requires in part certain permits for the use of City Parks and Recreational Facilities, and authorizes the adoptions of rules and regulations to apply to such facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, due to certain inconsistencies within Chapter 97, a recommendation has been made to revise Chapter 97 to clearly place authority for establishing the rules and regulations for the use of Parks and Recreational Facilities with City Council.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Montgomery, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** Section 97.01(C) of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 97.01(C) Violations of the terms and conditions for a permit authorized under subsections (A) or (B) above, or violation of any state statute governing the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages may result in the immediate revocation of any permit authorized herein.

**SECTION 2.** Section 97.03 of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 97.03 All use of Park and Recreation facilities shall be subject to the provisions of this Chapter and to the Rules and Regulations for Park and Recreation facilities approved from time to time by City Council. Such rules

and regulations, at the option of City Council, may be approved by Motion or Resolution. Anyone renting or reserving Park and Recreation facilities shall receive a copy of the current Rules and Regulations in effect at such time, which Rules and Regulations also shall be posted on the City's website. A convenient summary of the current relevant Rules and Regulations shall be posted within each Park and Recreation facility. A violation of such Rules and Regulations shall be considered a violation of this Code Section and may be cited as a minor misdemeanor, and/or such person or person's permit may be revoked, and/or such person or persons may be removed from the Park and Recreation facility.

**SECTION 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect the earliest opportunity as allowable by law.
