SUMMARY OF RESULTS

In Spring 2015, the University of Cincinnati Institute for Policy Research (IPR) surveyed City of Montgomery, Ohio households on behalf of Management Partners. The survey was the latest in a series, conducted every five years, designed to assist the City in the development of its strategic plan. Over time, the survey has asked City households about the quality of life in the City and their attitudes and opinions about City services. The survey also includes questions about communication with the City, and about several policy questions related to development and leaf collection practices. Detailed results of these questions are presented in Figure and Chart form (Appendix 1.1) and Detailed Tabular form (Appendix 1.2) in appendices to this document.

In April and May 2015, City of Montgomery households were invited to participate in the survey via a mailed invitation that included a web address for the survey and a unique password for each household. Respondents who wished to fill out a survey and return it via mail were permitted to do so. A total of 911 Montgomery households participated in the survey; 857 surveys were completed via the web and 54 surveys were completed and returned by mail. The response rate for the survey was 23%.

Several conclusions can be drawn from the survey:

- Most households report satisfaction with the quality of life in Montgomery. A majority (67%) of households report they are “very satisfied” with the quality of life in Montgomery, while an additional 32 percent are “satisfied” (Chart 1).
 - A majority of households in each section of the City (see Figure 1 for a graphic display of these sections) report being “very satisfied” with the quality of life in Montgomery (Chart 2).
 - The survey also included the question: “What do you think will be the single most important issue facing the City of Montgomery during the next five years?” The verbatim responses to this question are included in Appendix 2.1.

- The 2015 survey asked: “Approximately 15 cents out of every \$1.00 homeowners pay in property taxes are used to help fund City of Montgomery municipal services (the remaining property tax dollars go to the schools, Hamilton County, and other county service providers such as the Zoo, Children Services and Senior Services). Do you agree or disagree with the following statement: The municipal services provided to my household are a good value for the property tax dollars I/we pay.” Just under nine of ten households (88%) agree (either “strongly” or “somewhat”) with this statement (Chart 3).
- As in previous years, City of Montgomery households were asked to evaluate the importance of City services to their household. Survey respondents identify fire and emergency medical services (EMS) (86%) and police protection (83%) as “extremely important” more frequently than other services presented in the survey (Chart 4).
 - Recreation programs (20%) is the only service presented in the survey rated “not very important” or “not at all important” by at least 1 in 5 households City-wide. However, it should be noted that whether or not children live in a particular household impacts how households answer this question. For example, households with no children report recreation programs are “not very important” or “not at all important” (23%) more frequently than households with children (15%). Further, while just 38 percent of households with no children report recreation programs are “extremely” or “very important,” a majority of households with children (55%) say these programs are “extremely” or “very important.”
- A majority of respondents report satisfaction (either “very satisfied” or “satisfied”) with each of the City of Montgomery services presented in the survey (Chart 5). The two services identified most frequently as “extremely important” are also the two services households most frequently report being “very satisfied” with: fire and emergency medical services (77%) and police protection (74%).

City of Montgomery households were asked their opinion of leaf collection practices and opinions regarding replacing the current leaf collection program with a leaf vacuuming service.

- A majority of households (61%) are satisfied (either “very satisfied” or “satisfied”) with the City's unlimited fall yard waste collection program, while 15 percent are dissatisfied (either “very dissatisfied” or “dissatisfied”) and six percent are neither satisfied nor dissatisfied (Chart 6). An additional 18 percent of respondents say they do not use the current fall yard waste collection program.
 - The percentage of respondents who say they do not use the current fall yard waste collection program is higher in Section 1 (21%), Section 2 (23%) and Section 4 (18%) than in Section 3 (12%) (Chart 7).
 - Reasons offered for either satisfaction or dissatisfaction with the fall yard waste collection program are included in Appendix 2.2.
- Households were also asked the following question: “The City of Montgomery is studying its leaf collection practices. Some residents favor the idea of replacing the current program with a curbside leaf vacuuming service, while others oppose the idea of replacing the current program with a curbside leaf vacuuming service. Would your household favor or oppose replacing the current leaf collection program with a leaf vacuuming service?” Forty-five percent favor replacing the current program with a leaf vacuuming service, 30 percent oppose and 26 percent neither favor nor oppose (Chart 8).
 - Households dissatisfied with the current fall yard waste collection favor replacing the current leaf collection program with a leaf vacuuming service at a far higher rate (92%) than other households (Chart 9).
 - Reasons offered for either favoring or opposing replacing the current leaf collection program are included in Appendix 2.3.
- Households were next asked whether they would be more likely to favor or more likely to oppose replacing the current leaf collection program with a curbside leaf vacuuming service if a fee were charged due to increase service costs. Sixty percent of households say information about a fee being assessed due to an increase in service costs makes them more likely to oppose replacing the current program (Chart 10).

These results suggest that should the City decide to pursue a City-wide change in its leaf collection practices, additional discussion between residents and City administration may be necessary. First, while a majority of residents are satisfied, (either “very satisfied” or “satisfied”) with the current leaf collection program, nearly 1 in 5 say their household does not use the program. Second, residents with an opinion on the idea of replacing the current service with a leaf vacuuming service more frequently favor the idea than oppose it, while about 1 in 4 households do not offer a favor or oppose opinion on the issue. Finally, it is not surprising to find more residents opposed to a vacuuming program if additional fees are introduced as part of a program – anti-fee sentiment is fairly typical in many communities. Of note also is that for about 3 of 10 respondents, the generic idea of a fee has no impact on their opinion. The question does not, however, provide guidance as to whether opinions might change if a smaller, versus a larger, fee amount were introduced as part of the program.

Households were also asked a series of questions about information sources and communication efforts made by the City.

- Eighty-six percent of households identify the Montgomery Bulletin as their number one source of information about City of Montgomery services, projects or events (not displayed; Question 3, Appendix 1.2).
- When asked the best way to provide information directly to their household, respondents most frequently suggest the U.S. mail (59%), followed by e-mail 38% (not displayed; Question 6, Appendix 1.2). These percentages have changed markedly since this question was first asked in 2005, when 85 percent said the best way to provide information directly to them was through the U.S. Mail, and about 10 percent said the best way to provide information was through e-mail.
- Survey respondents were also asked to rate the usefulness of communication efforts made by the City. A large majority find the Montgomery Bulletin to be “very useful” (81%) (Chart 11). Most survey respondents have also visited the City website (84%) and a large majority find it to be “very useful” (36%) or “somewhat useful” (44%)(Chart 12).
 - Not all communications are as widely used at this time as the Bulletin and web site, however. A majority of households report they have not seen City of Montgomery social media (67%) or email communications from the City (51%) (not displayed; Question 5f and 5g, Appendix 1.2).

Households were also asked about their direct contact with the City. Responses to these questions are displayed below.

- As in previous surveys, households contacting the City of Montgomery with a request for service or assistance are far more positive than negative about the experience (not displayed; Questions 10 and 11, Appendix 1.2).
 - Sixty-five percent of survey respondents say the City was responsive to their request for service or assistance and just seven percent say the City was not responsive. Overall, about 28 percent of City households responding to the survey report they have not contacted the City of Montgomery with a request for service or assistance.
 - Seventy percent of Montgomery households say their household was treated with courtesy when a request for service or assistance was made and just two percent say the City representative they spoke with was not courteous.

City households were asked their opinion of a series of potential development options for downtown Montgomery's Heritage District. The results of these questions are summarized below and in Chart 13.


- Far more respondents favor than oppose the following Heritage District development options:
 - "City purchasing property located in the Heritage District to ensure that future development is consistent with the character of the District" (79% favor "strongly" or "somewhat");
 - Enhancing public space in the Heritage District (e.g. enhancements to Parrot Alley, Neuilly- Plaisance Square) (75% favor "strongly" or "somewhat"); and
 - "encouraging residential development in and around the Heritage District" (65% favor "strongly" or "somewhat").

Households were also asked several questions about volunteer activity. The results of these questions are summarized below.

- Households were asked about volunteer activity with a variety of organizations (not displayed; Question 19a through 19g, Appendix 1.2). The most frequent type of volunteer activity, defined as devoting time at least “a few times a year,” is for church or religious groups (48%).
 - Fewer households report volunteer activity for school or tutoring programs (30%), child or youth programs (25%), neighborhood or community groups (20%), service organizations (12%) or City government (9%).
 - Forty-seven percent reported volunteering for an organization not included on the list included in the survey.
- When asked their level of interest in volunteering for a City of Montgomery local government commission, committee, or special project/event, six percent of households say “very interested,” 21 percent are “somewhat interested,” 45 percent are “not too interested” and 28 percent are “not at all interested” (not displayed; Question 20, Appendix 1.2).

Demographic characteristics of respondents to the City of Montgomery Survey of Residents are included in Charts 14-18, and summarized below.

- Respondents to the survey most frequently reside in Sections 3 (28%), 1 (27%) and 4 (25%), while fewer respondents reside in Section 2 (20%) (Chart 14).
- A large majority of respondents to the survey have lived in the City for more than five years (81%) (Chart 15).
- A majority of respondents (61%) to the survey do not have children under the age of 18 living in their household (Chart 16).
- Seventy-five percent of respondents say recycling is “very important” to their household (Chart 17).
- Thirty-eight percent of respondents say disposing of leaves using recycling practices like mulching and composting is “very important” to their household, 33 percent say “somewhat important,” 19 percent say “not too important,” and 11 percent say disposing of leaves using recycling practices is “not at all important” to their household (Chart 18).

Figure 1. Geographic Sections of the City of Montgomery

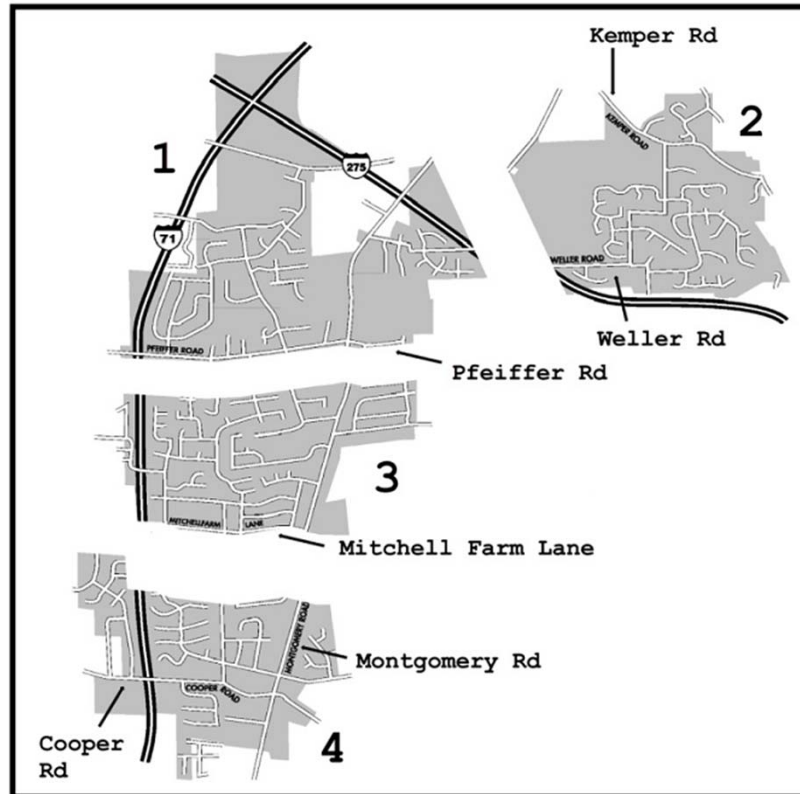

“All things considered, how satisfied are you with the quality of life in the City of Montgomery?”

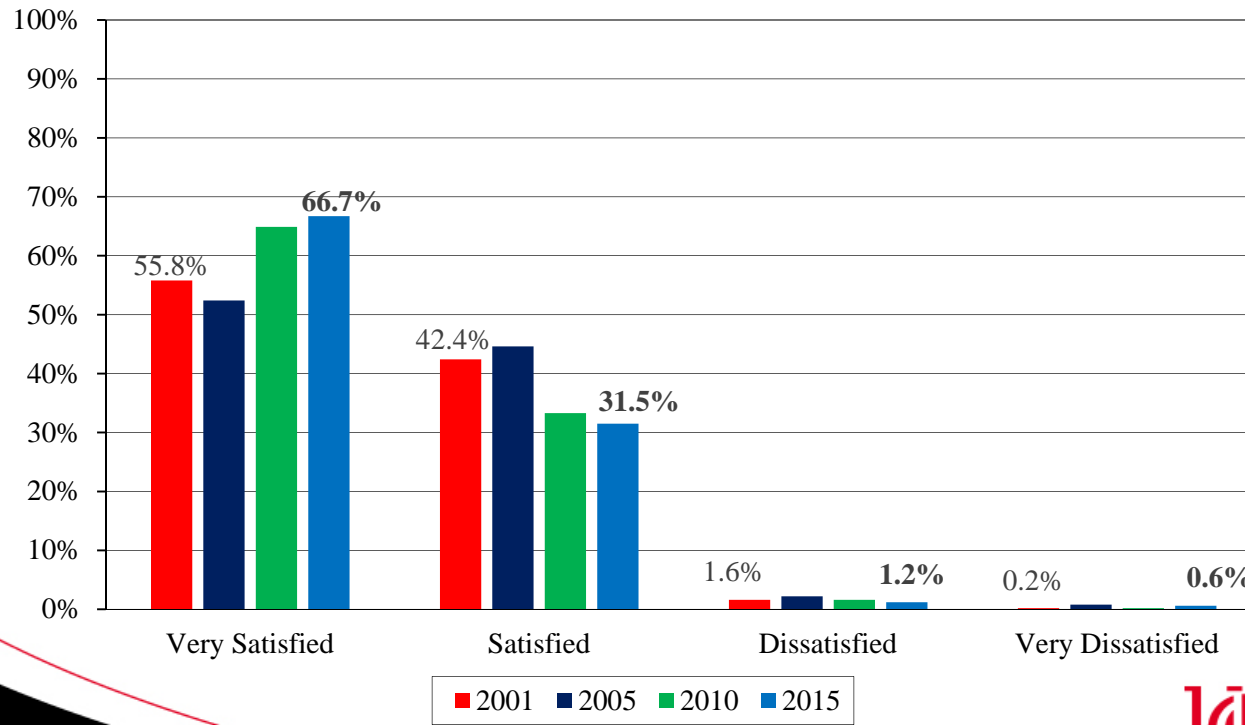

“All things considered, how satisfied are you with the quality of life in the City of Montgomery?”

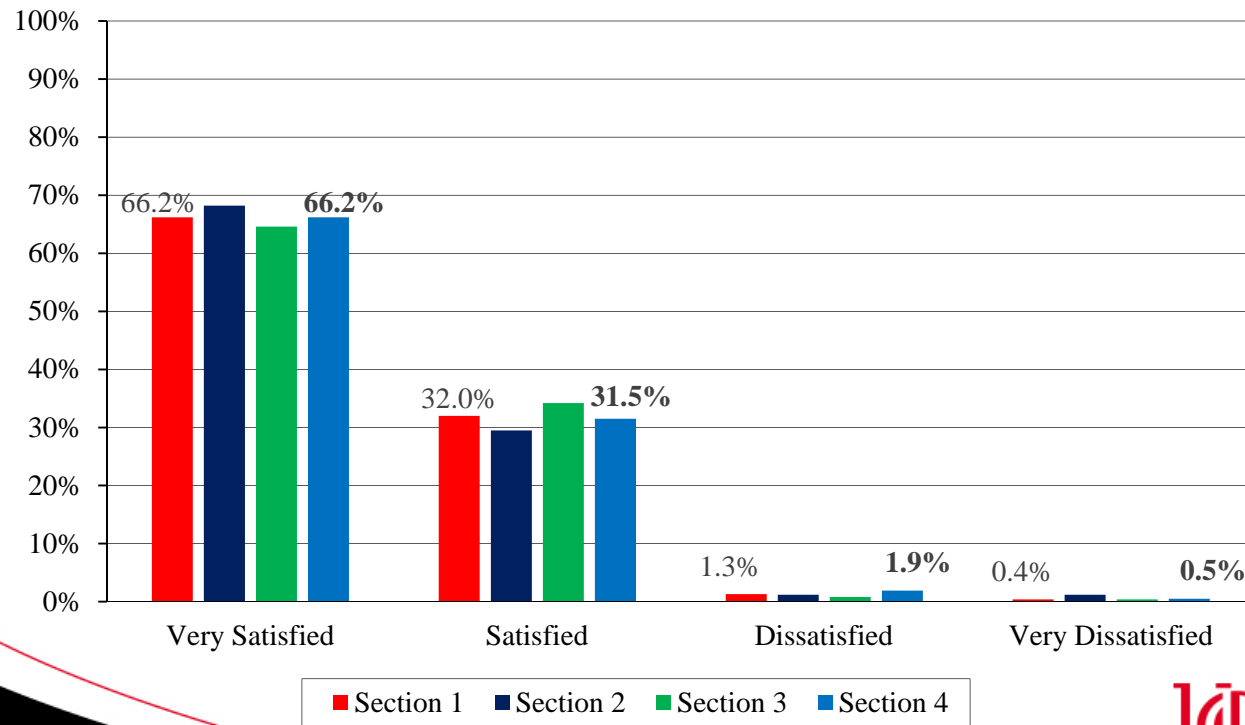

(Percent “Strongly Agree” and “Strongly Disagree”)

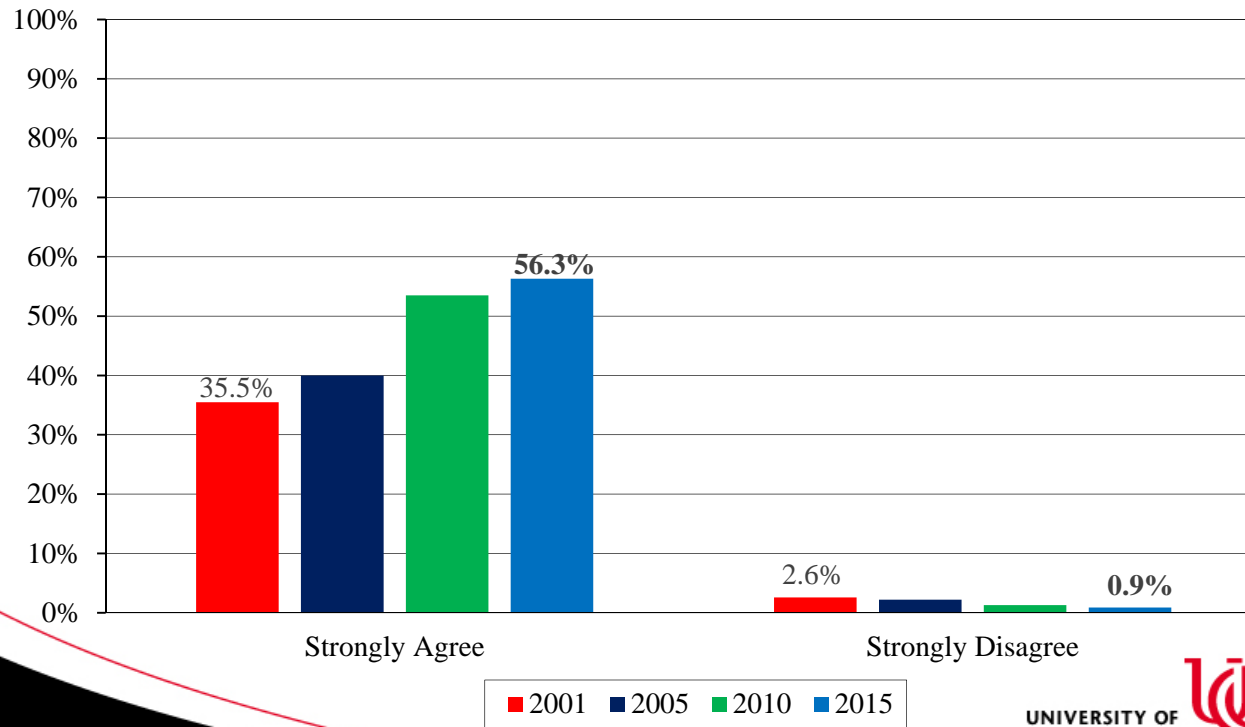

(Percent “Extremely Important”)

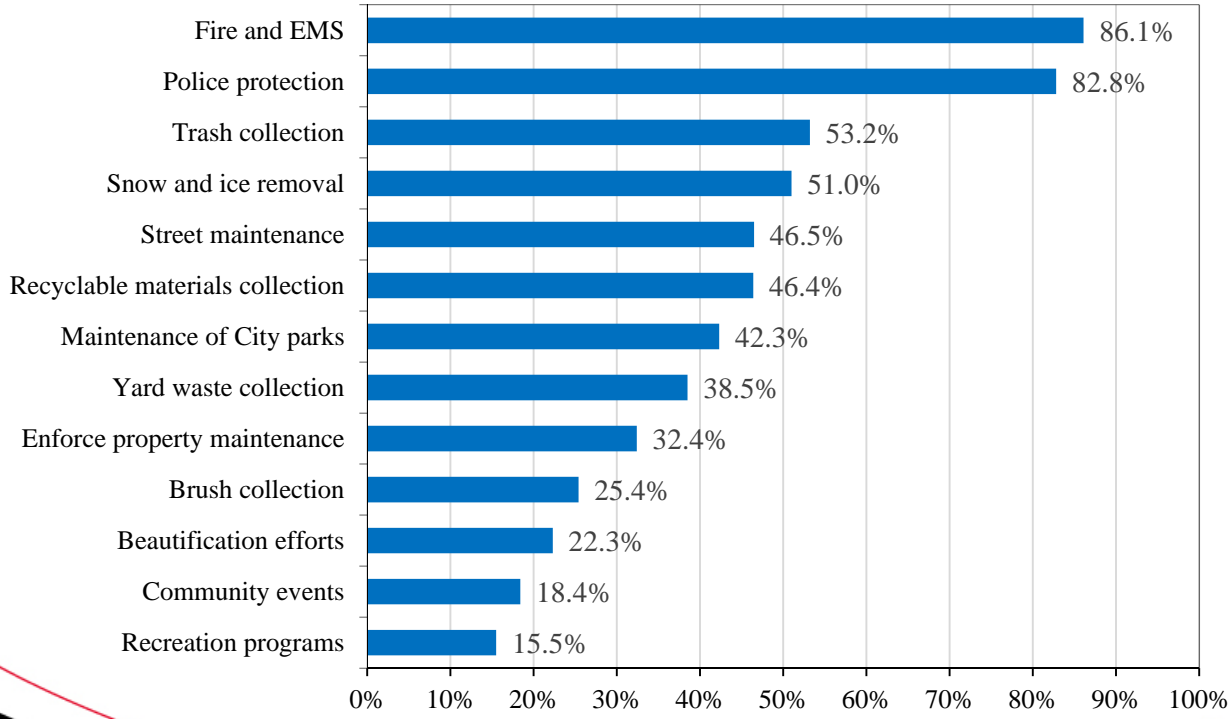

(Percent “Very Satisfied” or “Satisfied”)

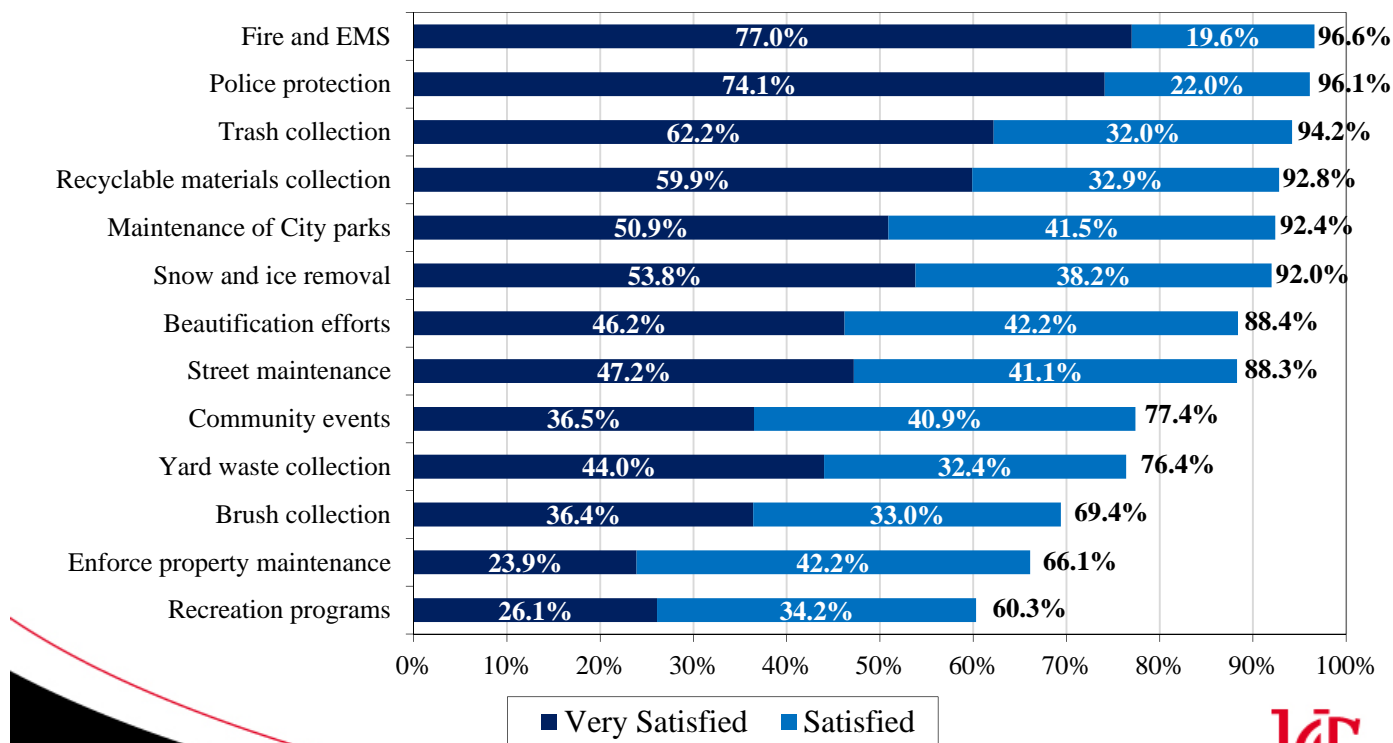

“How satisfied would you say you are with the City of Montgomery’s unlimited fall yard waste collection program?”

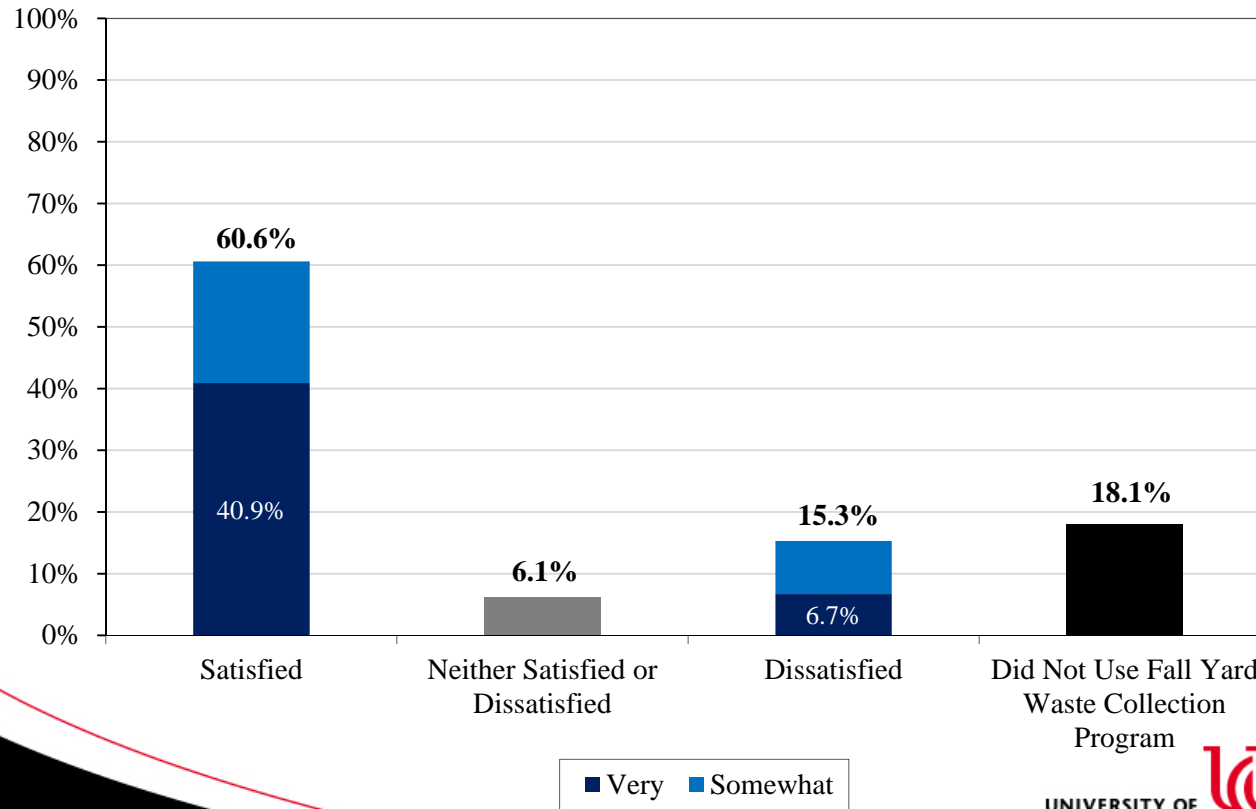

(Percent “**Did not use** fall yard waste collection program”)

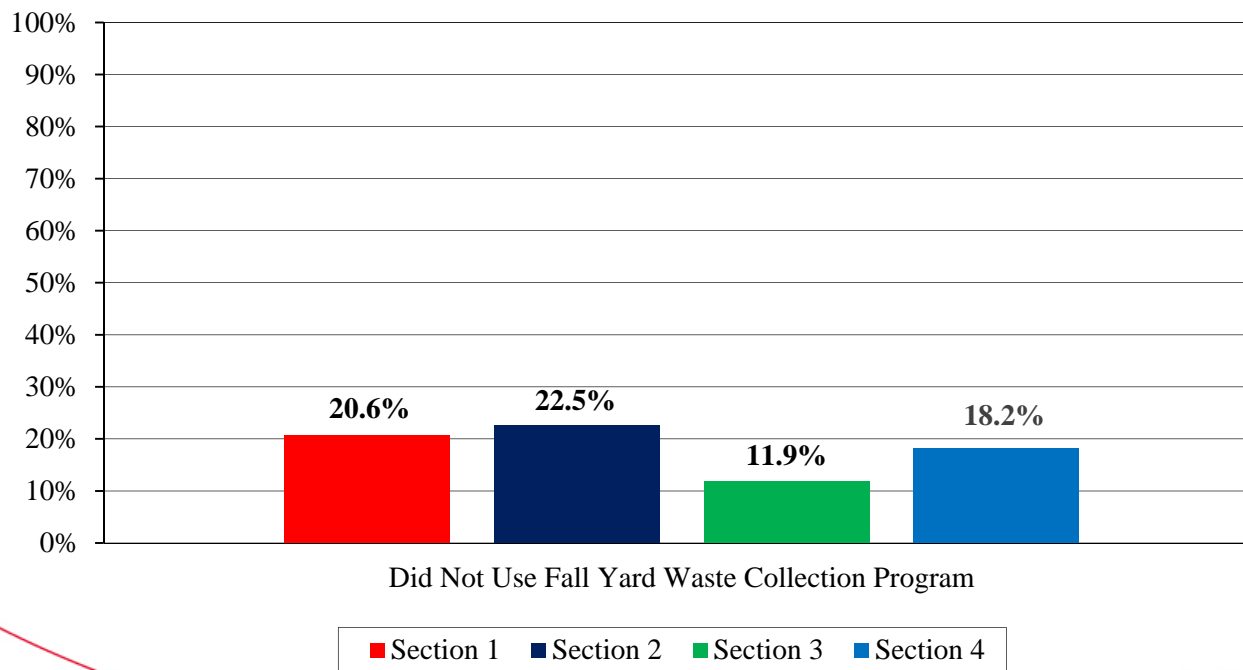

“Would your household favor or oppose replacing the current leaf collection program with a leaf vacuuming service?”

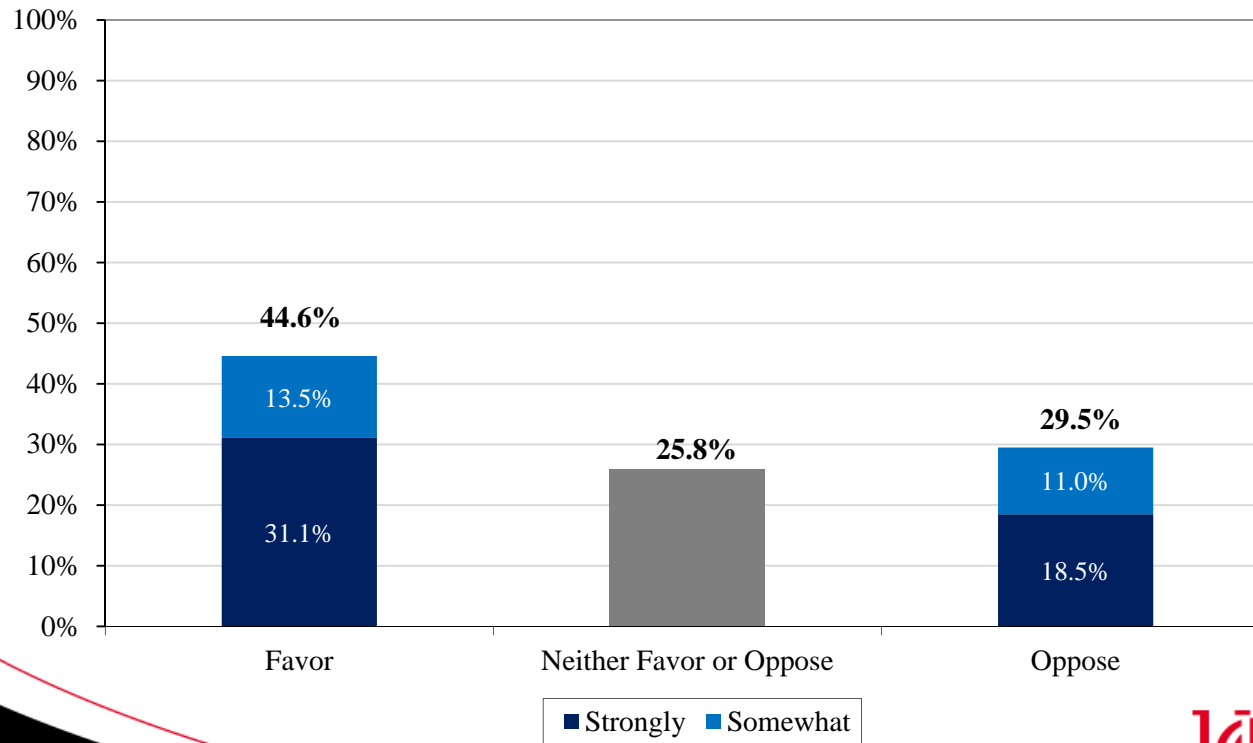

 (Percent “Strongly Favor” and “Somewhat Favor”)

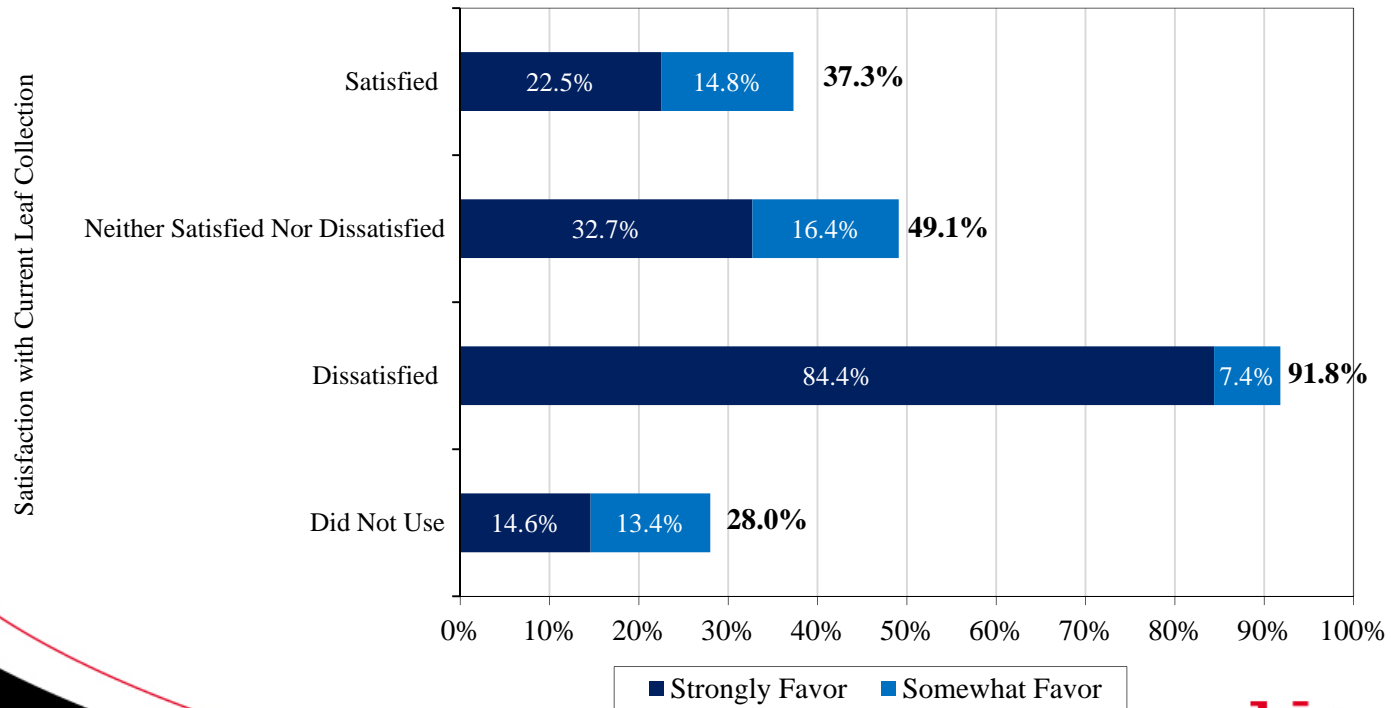

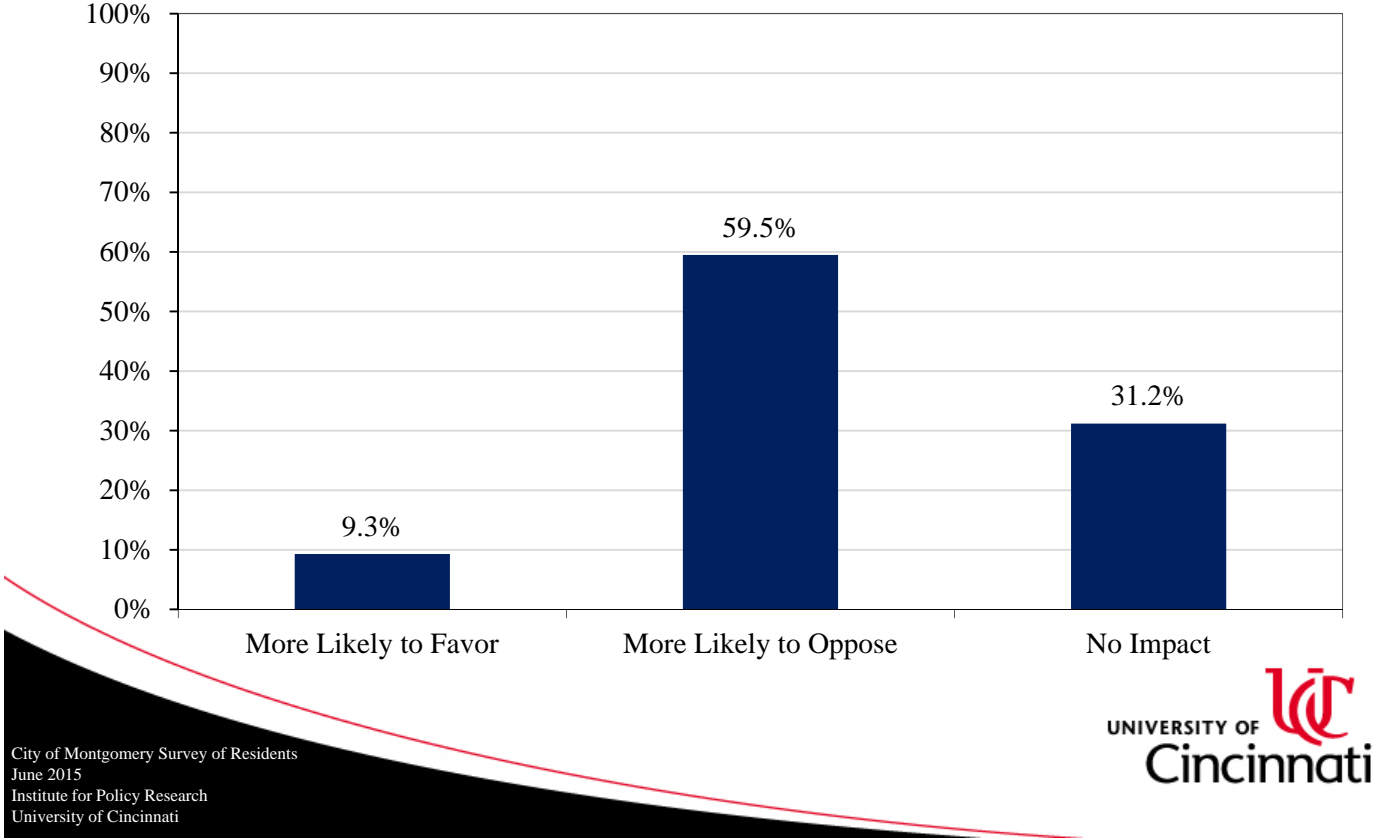

Usefulness of Montgomery Bulletin

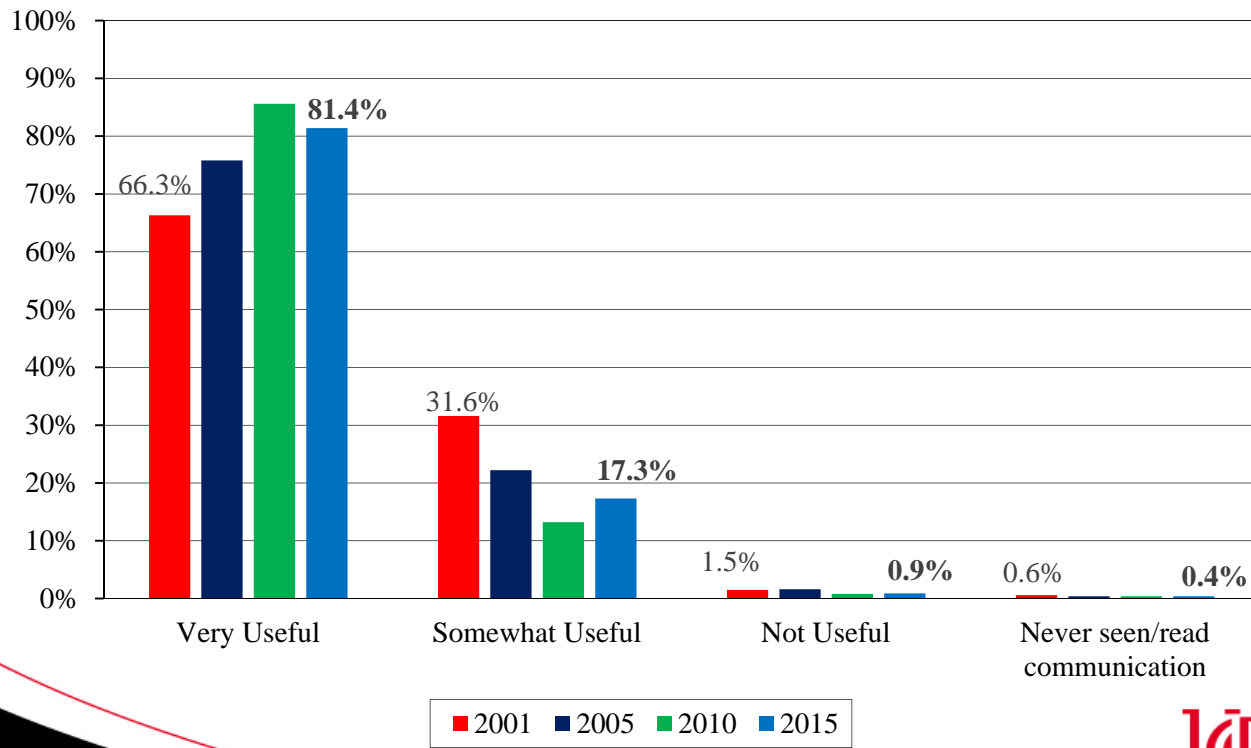

Usefulness of the City of Montgomery Web Site

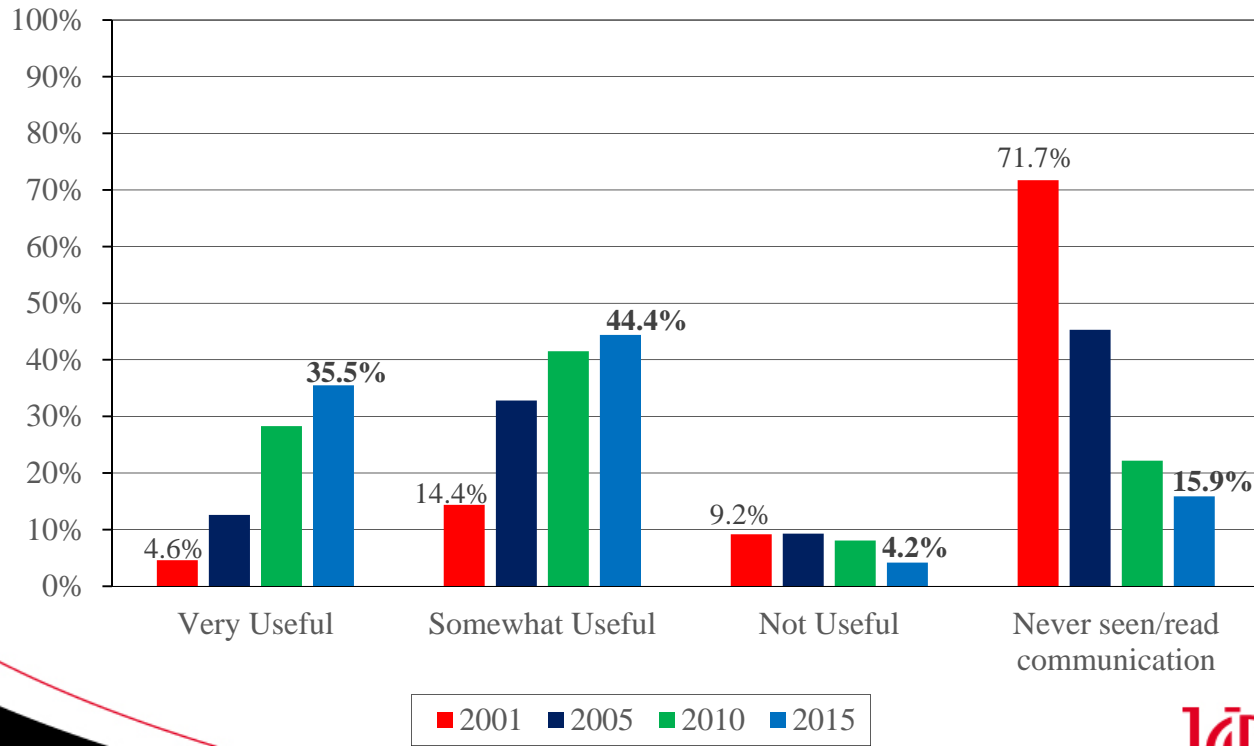
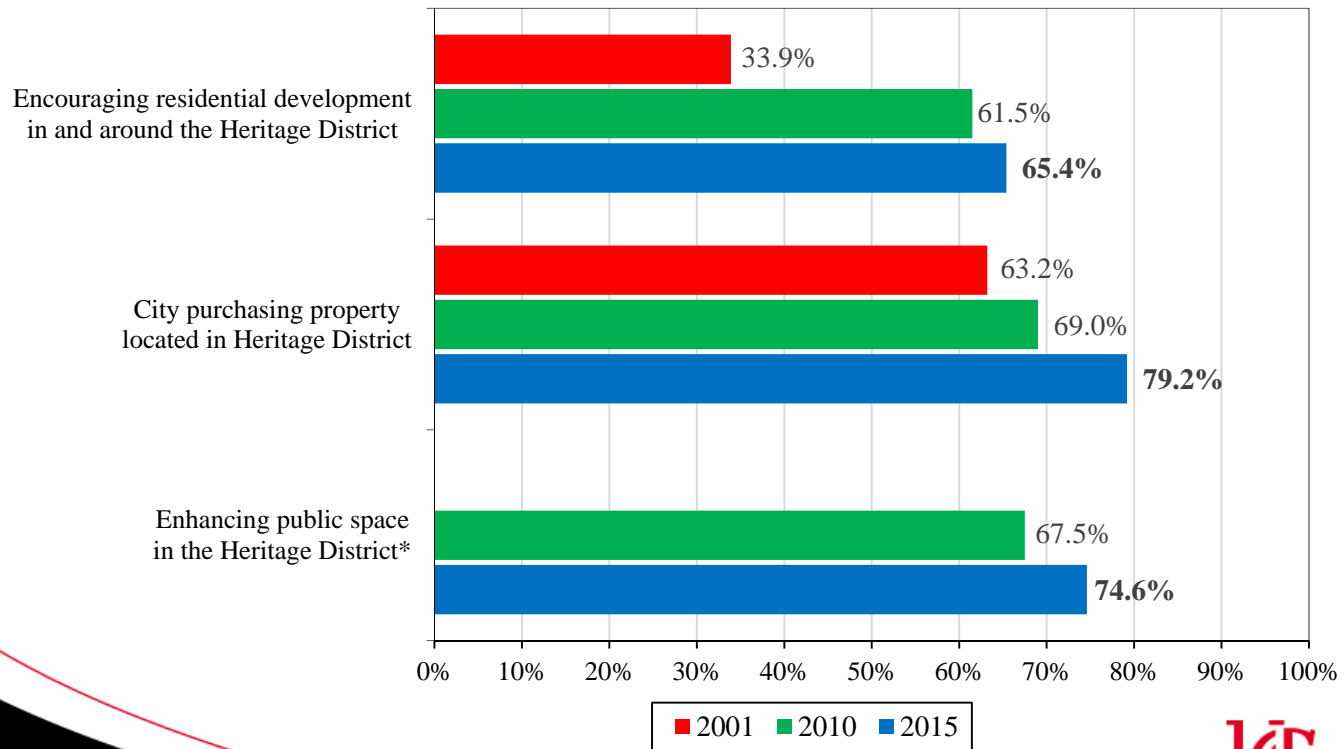


Chart 13.

 City of Montgomery Geographic Sections

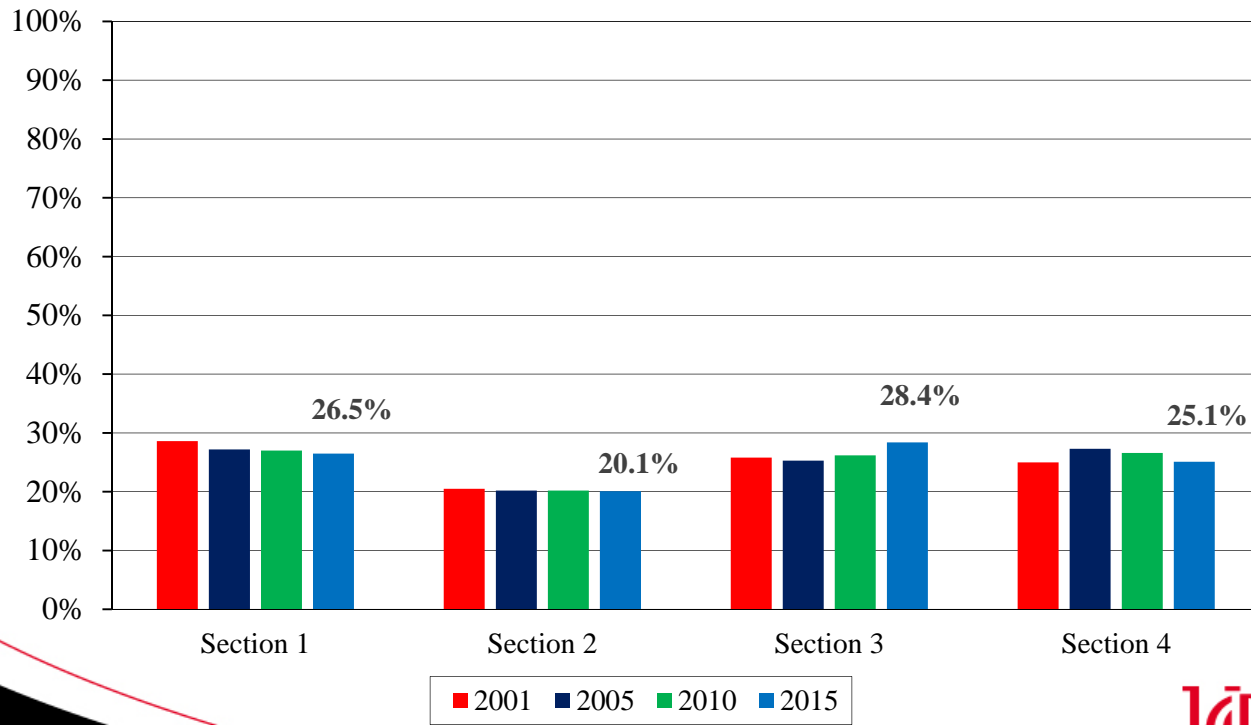

the City of Montgomery?”

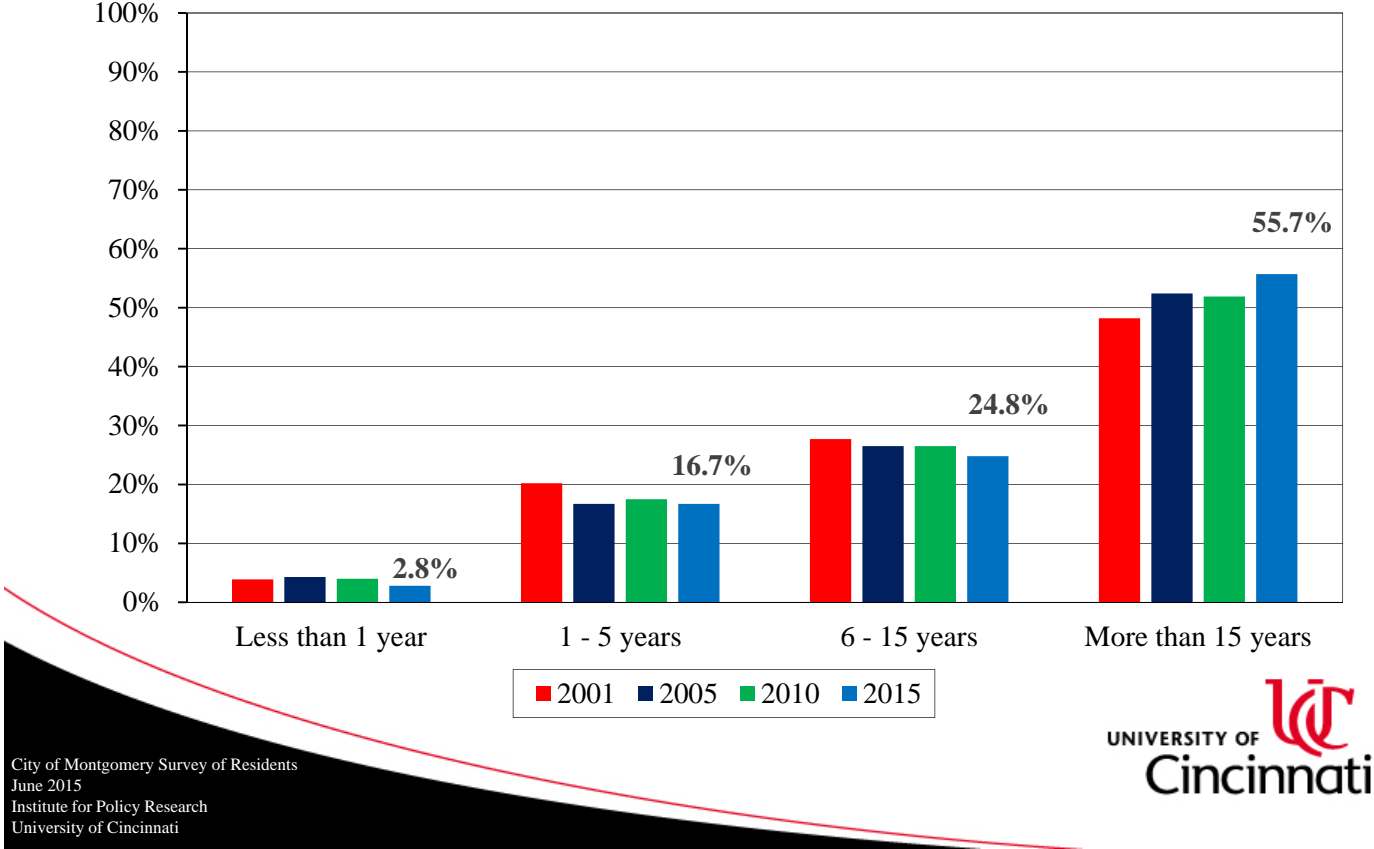

Among Survey Respondents

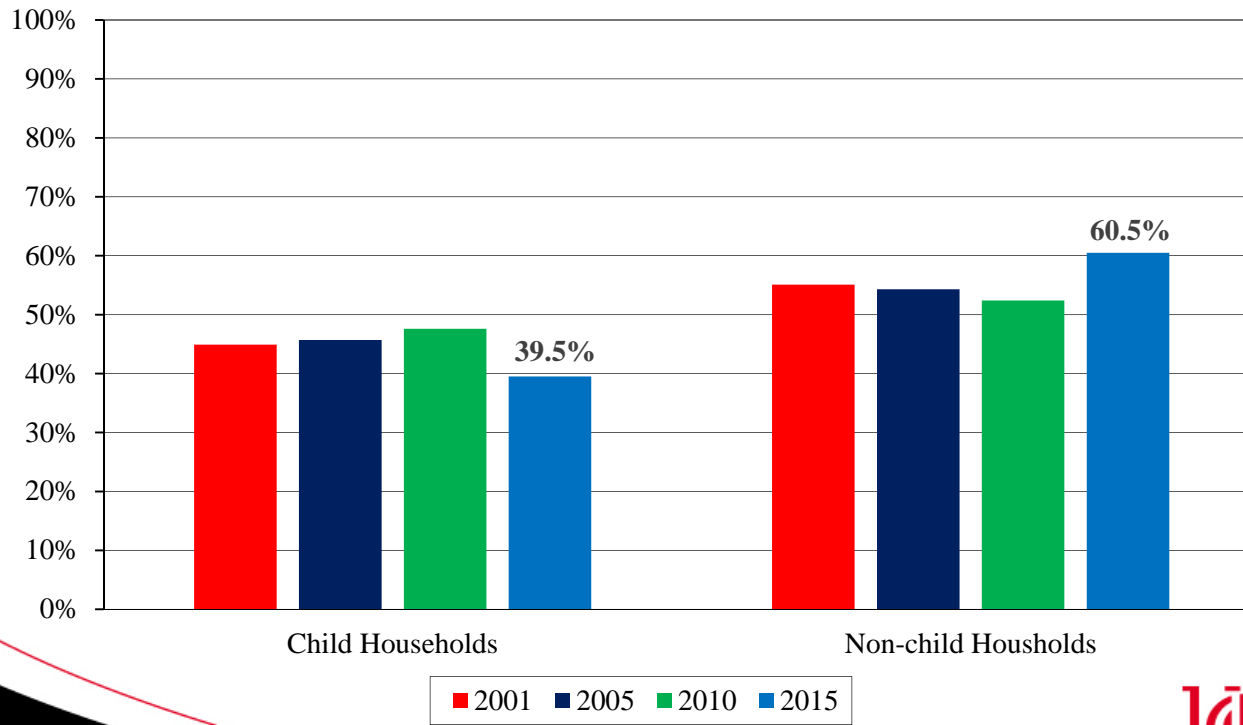

“Overall, how important is RECYCLING to your household?”

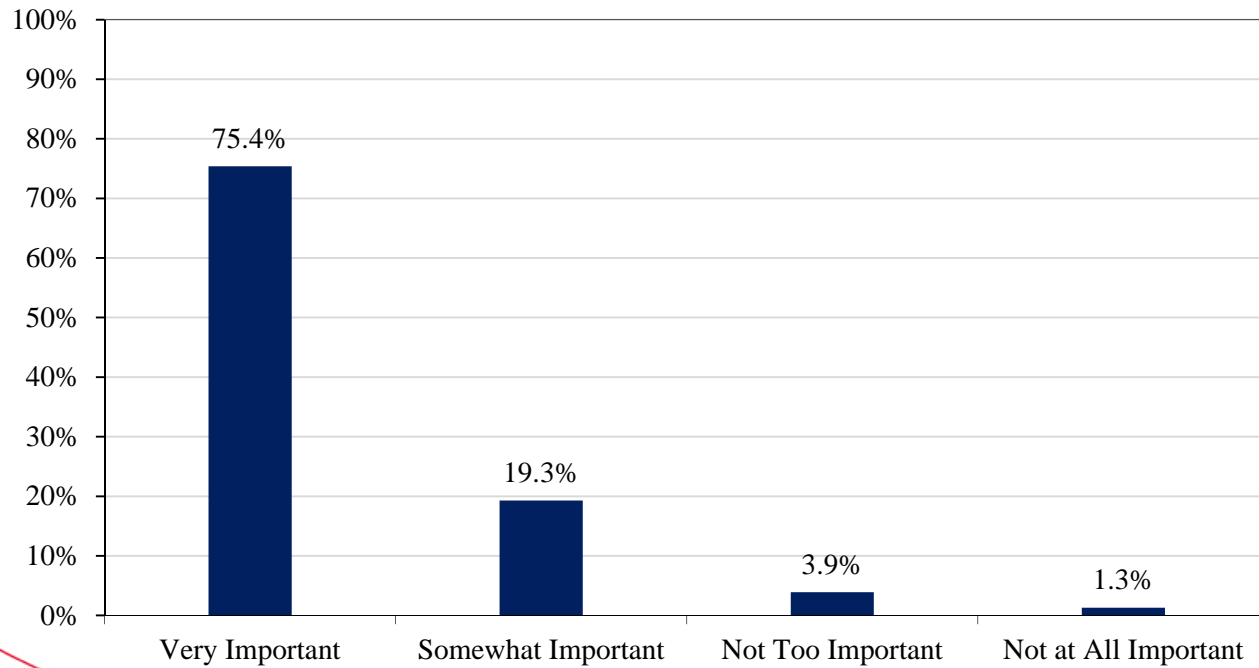
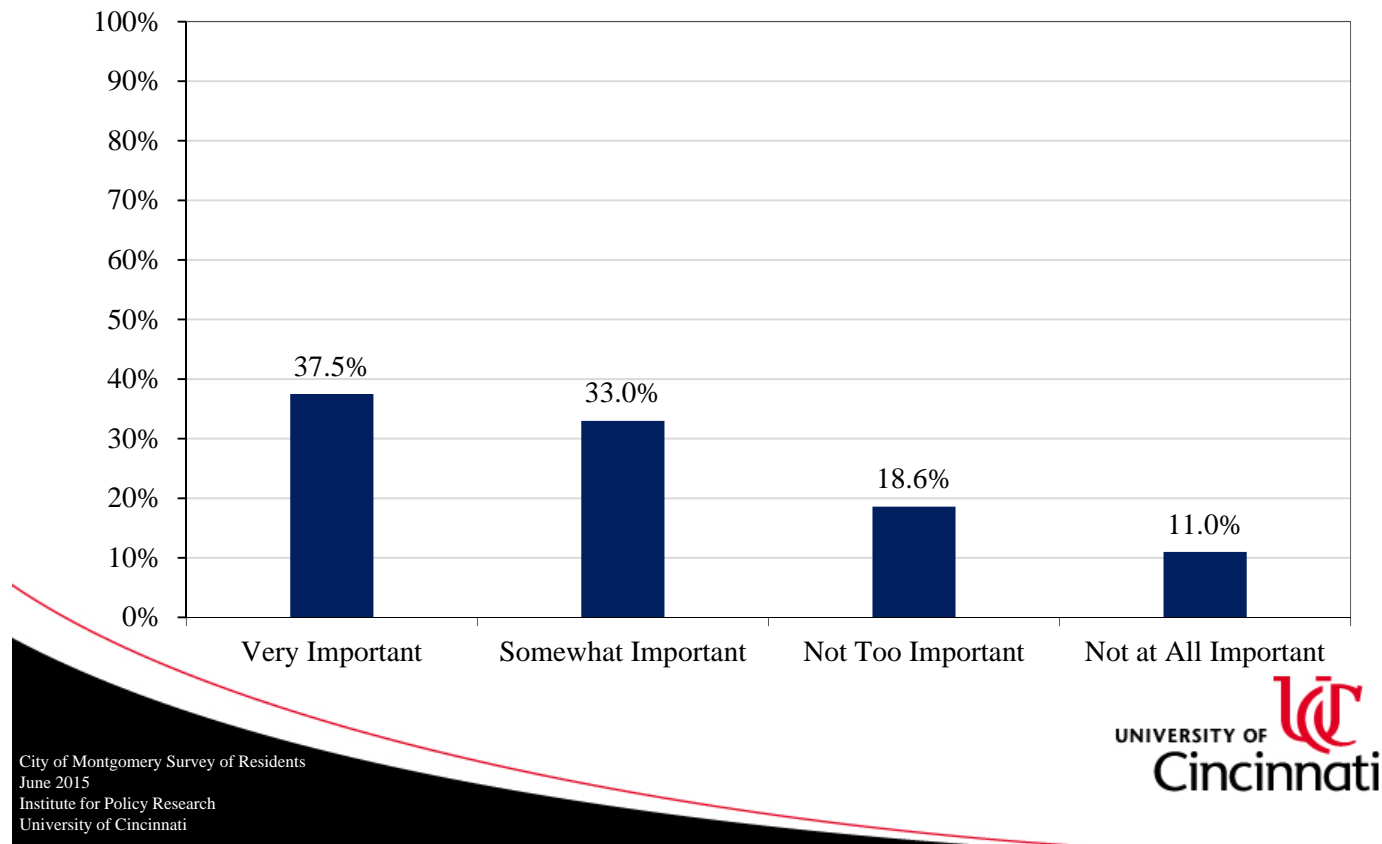
