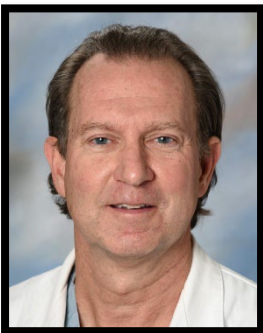


Dr. Clint Hutson, MD President & Chief Operating Officer, Bethesda North Hospital

Dr. Hutson received his medical from the University of Kentucky College of Medicine and completed his residency training at Virginia Commonwealth University.



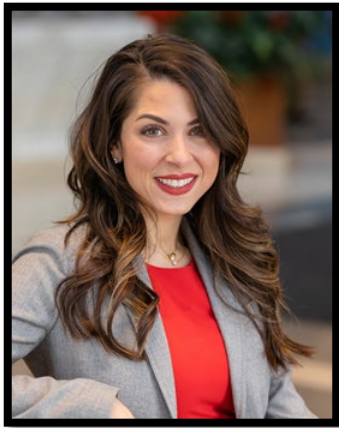
Dr. Douglas Adams, MD
