CONSTITUTION WEEK PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS Our Founding Fathers, in order to secure the blessings of liberty did ordain and adopt a Constitution for the United States of American on September 17, 1787, establishing the world's first government of the people, by the people and for the people; and

WHEREAS September 17, 2023, marks the two hundred thirty-sixth anniversary of the signing of the Unites States Constitution, providing a historic opportunity for all Americans to remember the achievements of our Founding Fathers and to reflect on the rights and privileges of citizenship, as well as its responsibilities; and

WHEREAS It is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary; and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

WHEREAS Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week,

NOW, THEREFORE I, Dwayne Cole, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Munford in the State of Tennessee do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through 23 as **CONSTITUTION WEEK:**

AND ask our citizens to reaffirm the ideals of the Framers of the constitution had in 1787 by vigilantly supporting, preserving, and defending the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties, remembering that lost rights may never be regained.
