Congressman David Kustoff is co-sponsoring legislation, the Easy Access to Mail Act, which would prohibit the Postal Service from applying the new standards retroactively, hopefully eliminating the policy completely. This bill was introduced in April 2019 but Congress has been preoccupied with other matters.
