Mayor's Report
April 22, 2019

Aldermen,

The City of Munford has been recognized one of the "**2019 Best Communities for Music Education**" by **the North American Music Merchants (NAMM)**. The "Best Communities for Music Education" is a signature program of the NAMM Foundation that recognizes and celebrates communities, school districts, and schools for their support and commitment to music education and efforts to assure access to music for all students as a part of a well-rounded education. Many thanks to MHS Band Director Barry Trobaugh for submitting an application on behalf of our town and school. Congratulations to all.

As previously mentioned, our **local paving program** is now underway and is about 40% complete. I discussed the progress with our contractor today and was advised that they should be finished within two weeks, weather permitting. Clean up is included in the project and they will be picking up debris before completion. Fowler Paving will begin work in Glenview Estates around May 1, weather permitting and will begin reconstruction, re-configuring, and repaving of Doctors Drive when school is dismissed for summer vacation.

The Recycling Center, located on the corner of Haddad's Department Store parking lot, has been under construction and will reopen this week with the delivery of recycling bins. New concrete has been poured to improve the pad area where the bins are located and fencing will be installed to contain overflow and keep litter from blowing out of the area. This is one component of our "Make Munford, Tennessee Litter Free" initiative.

Munford clean-up day will be held on April 27 from 8:00 AM - 11:00 AM. "Keep Tipton County Beautiful" will provide trash bags, litter grippers, and safety vests for the event. Please meet at City Hall parking lot and we will disperse to clean up our town! Also a dumpster will be temporarily placed on City Hall parking lot and will be open to the public for dumping trash and lawn clippings. Please do not place batteries, tires, or hazardous waste in the dumpster. It will remain until May 5.

We will join with millions of Americans to observe **National Day of Prayer** on May 2 at 6:30 PM at the Gazebo in City Park in Munford. Jody Johnson, Pastor of Faith Baptist Church of Tipton County, is coordinator for this year's event. Please join Pastor Johnson and me, along with many others, as we ask God's blessings on our nation and town.
