We received very exciting news on August 15 that ALL THREE of our schools were recognized by the State of Tennessee as **Level 5 and Reward Schools**. A reward school is one with outstanding student achievement or growth over the past three years. Reward School recognition is the highest designation a school may attain. Congratulations to all our students, teachers, and administrators for their strong efforts to achieve this high honor. Our schools are one of the main reasons we continue to say, "Munford is My Kind of Town."

We are now in the midst of Celebrate Season, having completed the second event of three with the 20th running of the **Celebrate Munford 5K** on August 17. Over 200 runners participated and a portion of the proceeds are designated to help fund the Munford-Tipton County Memorial Public Library. The third and final event of **Celebrate Munford 2019** is our annual festival to be held on September 21 in downtown Munford.
