On October 6, the Tennessee Comptroller presented the City of Munford a certificate recognizing us for the timely adoption of a balanced budget for the current fiscal year. This certificate was awarded based on the adoption of our budget before the end of the previous fiscal year and being filed with the Comptroller's office within 15 days of adoption with no issues of concern during their review. Also, the city is not currently under the oversight of the Water & Wastewater Financing Board. This is recognition of efficient government and financial responsibility of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen. Special thanks to City Recorder Sherry Yelvington for her guidance and efficiency in preparing proper documentation.

Sales tax revenues remain strong as our citizens shop local and support hometown businesses. The latest revenues are up 21.5% over previous year. Thank you, Munford and South Tipton County, for supporting local small businesses!!

I am pleased to announce that the City of Munford is cooperating with Dr. John Combs and Tipton County Schools to offer Wi-Fi hotspots for students who need internet access. The location serving the Munford area is at Centennial Park, located at 158 Reeder Avenue in Munford. We are pleased to provide this well-lit and safe area for students who need it.
