Chapter 9 Management Agency and Community Involvement

This chapter discusses the contribution of local jurisdictions and the general public in the update of this plan. It also discusses the public meetings which will present the plan to the general public. Local government collaboration and public involvement have been integral in the plan update process.

Local Collaboration

Clean Water Plan Chapter Committees

NEFCO organized committees to discuss and review changes made to the following Clean Water Plan chapters:

- Chapter 3 Wastewater Management Facilities Planning
- Chapter 4 The Management of Home Sewage Treatment Systems, Semi-public Disposal Systems, and Small Flow On-site Sewage Treatment System
- Chapter 5 Management of Nonpoint Source Pollution and Storm Water Runoff

The members of each committee consisted of representatives from local, regional, and state entities that are involved with the planning, implementation, and/or enforcement of various programs presented in each chapter. The committee members are listed after a brief summary of the committee's work.

The Chapter 3 committee, called the Clean Water Plan Amendments Process Committee, held a meeting on January 24, 2011. The committee members recommended changes to the facilities planning area (FPA) amendment guidelines, standardize wastewater treatment prescriptions as much as possible, and improve public notification of proposed FPA amendments. NEFCO staff incorporated the committee's recommendations into the Clean Water Plan for eventual review and consideration by NEFCO's Environmental Resources Technical Advisory Committee (ERTAC) and General Policy Board (GPB).

At a February 3 meeting, the Chapter 4 update committee recommended minor changes to the Clean Water Plan because many of the chapter's recommendation are still pertinent. The minor changes do include new wastewater programs that have been created since the last update, including Ohio EPA's National Pollution Discharge Elimination Systems (NPDES) general permit for discharging home sewage systems and monitoring of small flow on-site sewage treatment systems. The changes have been reviewed by the ERTAC and recommended for approval by the GPB.

Changes to Chapter 5 for the management of nonpoint source pollution and storm water runoff were discussed at the May 17, 2011, Update Clean Water Plan committee meeting. Several changes and additions were recommended for the chapter because the content was originally written prior to the implementation of the NPDES Storm Water Phase II Program. Many of chapter's original recommendations are now required as part of the Phase II program. Therefore, the committee recommended changes aimed at improving the various storm water programs in the NEFCO region, updating water quality information, focusing on

watershed/regional approaches to storm water management, and the need for a dedicated funding source for storm water programs. The proposed changes will be reviewed by the ERTAC and then forwarded to the GPB.

Environmental Resources Technical Advisory Committee (ERTAC)

The NEFCO ERTAC is organized as a functional committee of the General Policy Board. It is comprised of local governments and public agencies within and including Portage, Stark, Summit, and Wayne Counties which have regulatory and/or advisory environmental responsibilities. Included in the responsibilities of the ERTAC is to provide technical input to the Board and guidance to NEFCO's staff in maintaining and implementing the Clean Water Plan. The Committee also is organized as a forum for the discussion and study of environmentally-related problems of a regional nature; and for the development of policy, actions and recommendations pertaining to regional environmental issues. The ERTAC reviews all proposed changes to the Clean Water Plan and makes a recommendations to the GPB. A list of ERTAC members and alternates can be viewed in Table 9-1.

Public Meetings

In the summer of 2011, NEFCO will hold a public meeting to present changes made to the Clean Water Plan over the previous several months. All proposed changes will be posted on NEFCO's website (www.nefcoplanning.org) for review. The meeting will occur during a 45-day public review period where interested parties can comment on any of the proposed changes. The meeting will focus on the wastewater management facilities planning (Chapter 3) portion of the Clean Water Plan, but changes to other plan components will also be reviewed including home sewage management, nonpoint source pollution, and storm water runoff. The opinions and comments from the public meeting and website posting will be compiled and reviewed by

NEFCO staff, ERTAC, and the appropriate chapter committees for possible inclusion in the Clean Water Plan. NEFCO will keep and make available documentation of these activities. After the public meeting and review period, all proposed changes will be presented to NEFCO's ERTAC and GPB for approval consideration.
