

**SUBJECT:** Consideration of an Amendment to the Clean Water Plan for the Canton-Nimishillen Basin Facilities Planning Area (FPA) and the Massillon FPA to modify the FPA boundary to provide for the construction of Jackson Township's Schuring Park via a sanitary sewer connection on Belden Greens Circle NW, which is tributary to the Canton Water Reclamation Facility

**What's being requested:**

The Stark County Metropolitan Sewer District (SCMSD) is requesting an amendment to the Canton-Nimishillen Basin Facilities Planning Area (FPA) and Massillon FPA, Clean Water Plan Appendices 3-19 and 3-22, respectively, to:

- 1) expand the Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA boundary to include Schuring Park parcels 10011822 and 10011820, which are owned by Jackson Township, and to include approximately the northern one-half of parcel 10011778, which is owned by Stark Parks; and
- 2) redefine the Massillon FPA boundary to exclude Schuring Park parcels 10011822, and 10011820, and approximately the northern one-half of parcel 10011778

**Background (adapted from information provided by Jackson Township):**

The proposed amendment area is on Belden Greens Circle NW in Jackson Township, Stark County, within the Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA and Massillon FPA (Figure 1). In about December 2019, the former Tam O'Shanter golf course was purchased by Stark Parks and the Board of Trustees for Jackson Township. Jackson Township purchased the northern forty (40) acres, and the remaining acreage was purchased by Stark Parks. Upon finalizing the purchase, Jackson Township collaborated with Stark Parks to provide the citizens of Jackson Township and Stark County with an active park (Schuring Park) and passive park (Tam O' Shanter Park). Jackson Township and Stark Parks worked together to establish certain resources, e.g., picnic shelters, parking lots, restrooms, etc., on or around each jurisdiction's park to avoid duplication of resources near each other.

Jackson Township is in the process of completing construction drawings for the development of Schuring Park into a soccer/lacrosse complex and in doing so desires to locate certain restroom facilities on its own parcels (10011822, and 10011820), and on Stark Parks' abutting parcel 10011778.

**Facilities Planning Area (FPA) boundary change:**

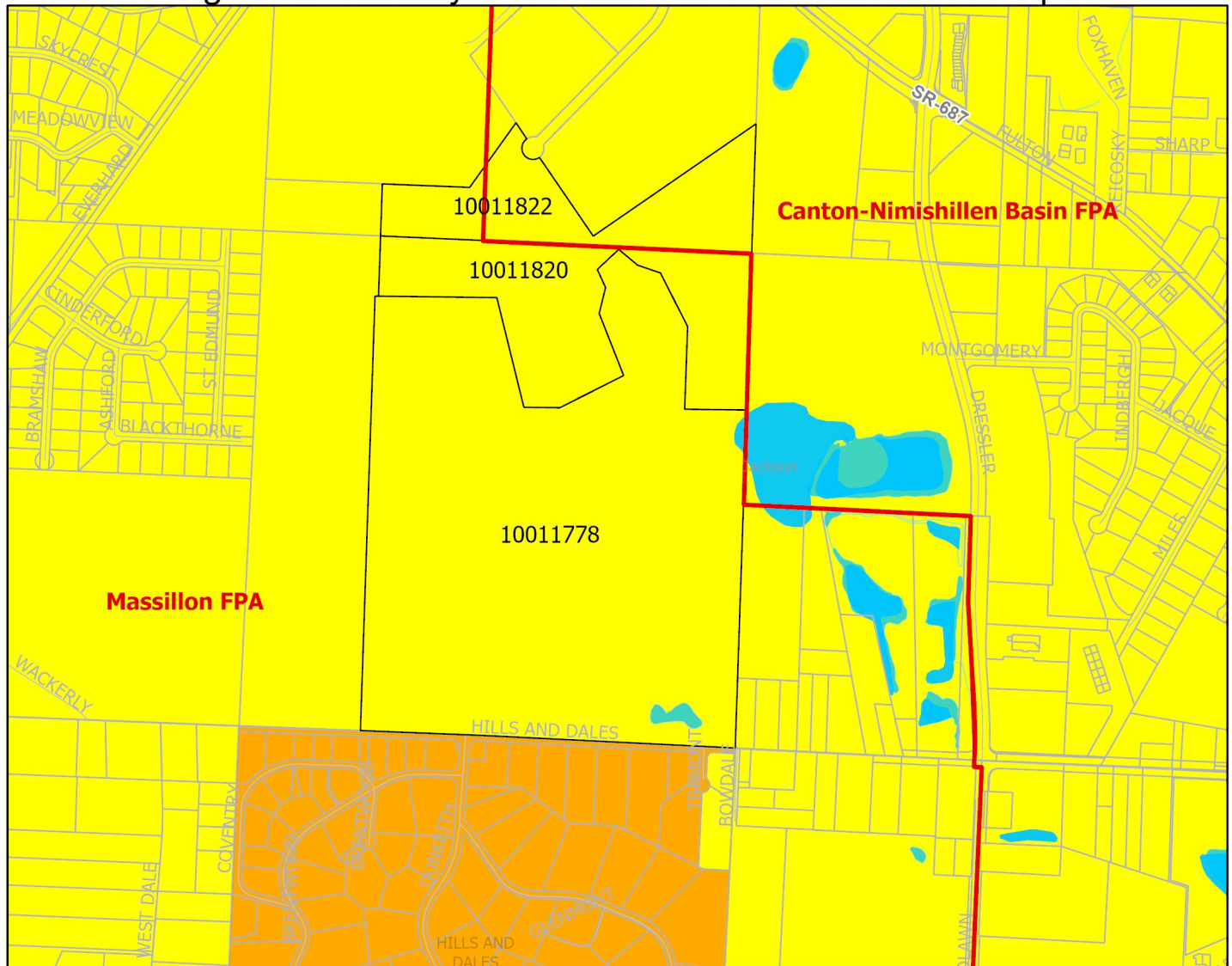




Figure 2 - Clean Water Plan Amendment

Schuring Park parcel 10011822 is in both the Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA and the Massillon FPA (Figure 2). Schuring Park parcel 10011820 and Stark Parks parcel 10011778 are in the Massillon FPA. The proposed FPA boundary modification will place Schuring Park parcels 10011822 and 10011820, and approximately the northern one-half of Stark Parks' parcel 10011778 completely within the Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA, allowing an economical means of wastewater transmission and treatment at the Canton Water Reclamation Facility. This facility has the capacity to accept the additional flow and loading, reducing geographical

challenges and economic impact for both construction and long-term maintenance and operation of the proposed wastewater infrastructure (Figure 2).

**Wastewater prescription change:**

There is no prescription change. The current prescription for the amendment area is 'yellow', meaning, "Areas Currently Served with Sanitary Sewer", which would not change with the amendment.

**Local governments/agencies affected:**

Stark County Board of Commissioners, Stark Parks, Stark County Health Department, City of Canton, City of Massillon, and Jackson Township. The attached responses from all six of these affected local government entities indicate that they have "no objection" to the amendment.

**Public notification efforts:**

A legal notice describing the proposed amendment was published in the Canton Repository on November 28, 2022 (attached). No comments were received by SCMSD.

**Specific proposed changes to the current FPA Appendix in the Clean Water Plan:**

Changes to Appendix 3-19 Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA, and to Appendix 3-22 Massillon FPA, only pertain to the FPA maps, reflecting the change in the FPA boundary.

**Staff recommendation:**

At the ERTAC meeting on January 4, 2023, staff recommended approval of the amendment.

**Environmental Resources Technical Advisory Committee (ERTAC) Recommendation to the NEFCO General Policy Board:**

The ERTAC recommended approval of the amendment.

**RESOLUTION OF THE GENERAL POLICY BOARD OF THE NORTHEAST OHIO FOUR COUNTY REGIONAL PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION (NEFCO) APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CLEAN WATER PLAN FOR THE CANTON-NIMISHILLEN BASIN FACILITIES PLANNING AREA (FPA) AND MASSILLON FPA TO MODIFY THE FPA BOUNDARY TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF JACKSON TOWNSHIP'S SCHURING PARK VIA A SANITARY SEWER CONNECTION ON BELDEN GREENS CIRCLE NW, WHICH IS TRIBUTARY TO THE CANTON WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY**

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**WHEREAS**, NEFCO is the designated water quality management planning agency for Portage, Stark, Summit and Wayne Counties; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of that designation it is NEFCO's responsibility to coordinate the use, amendments to, and updates of its Clean Water Plan, also known as the 208 Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, NEFCO has been requested by the Stark County Metropolitan Sewer District to consider an amendment to the Clean Water Plan for the Canton-Nimishillen Basin Facilities Planning Area (FPA) and the Massillon FPA to modify the FPA boundary to provide for the construction of Jackson Township's Schuring Park via a sanitary sewer connection on Belden Greens Circle NW, which is tributary to the Canton Water Reclamation Facility; and

**WHEREAS**, this amendment expands the Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA boundary to include Schuring Park parcels 10011822 and 10011820, which are owned by Jackson Township, and to include approximately the northern one-half of parcel 10011778, which is owned by Stark Parks; and

**WHEREAS**, this amendment redefines the Massillon FPA boundary to exclude Schuring Park parcels 10011822, and 10011820, and approximately the northern one-half of parcel 10011778; and

**WHEREAS**, this amendment does not change the wastewater treatment prescriptions for Schuring Park parcels 10011822, and 10011820, and approximately the northern one-half of parcel 10011778; and

**WHEREAS**, the affected local and county governments and all affected agencies have been contacted regarding the proposed amendment and none have objected to it; and

**WHEREAS**, a legal advertisement that described the proposed amendment and sought comments on it, yielded no comments or questions during the public comment period; and

**WHEREAS**, this amendment changes the maps from the current Clean Water Plan Appendix 3-19 Canton-Nimishillen Basin Facilities Planning Area, and Appendix 3-22 Massillon Facilities Planning Area, to reflect the change in the FPA boundary; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio EPA has requested NEFCO's approval of this amendment as a step in its permitting process; and

**WHEREAS**, the NEFCO Environmental Resources Technical Advisory Committee (ERTAC) performed a technical review of this request and recommended approval of the amendment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the NEFCO General Policy Board approves this amendment to the Clean Water Plan for the Canton-Nimishillen Basin Facilities Planning Area (FPA) and the Massillon FPA to modify the FPA boundary to provide for the construction of Jackson Township's Schuring Park via a sanitary sewer connection on Belden Greens Circle NW, which is tributary to the Canton Water Reclamation Facility. Furthermore, the Board directs staff to incorporate this amendment into NEFCO's Clean Water Plan and to transmit pertinent amendment materials to the Stark County Metropolitan Sewer District, Stark County Board of Commissioners, Stark Parks, Stark County Health Department, City of Canton, City of Massillon, Jackson Township, and Ohio EPA.

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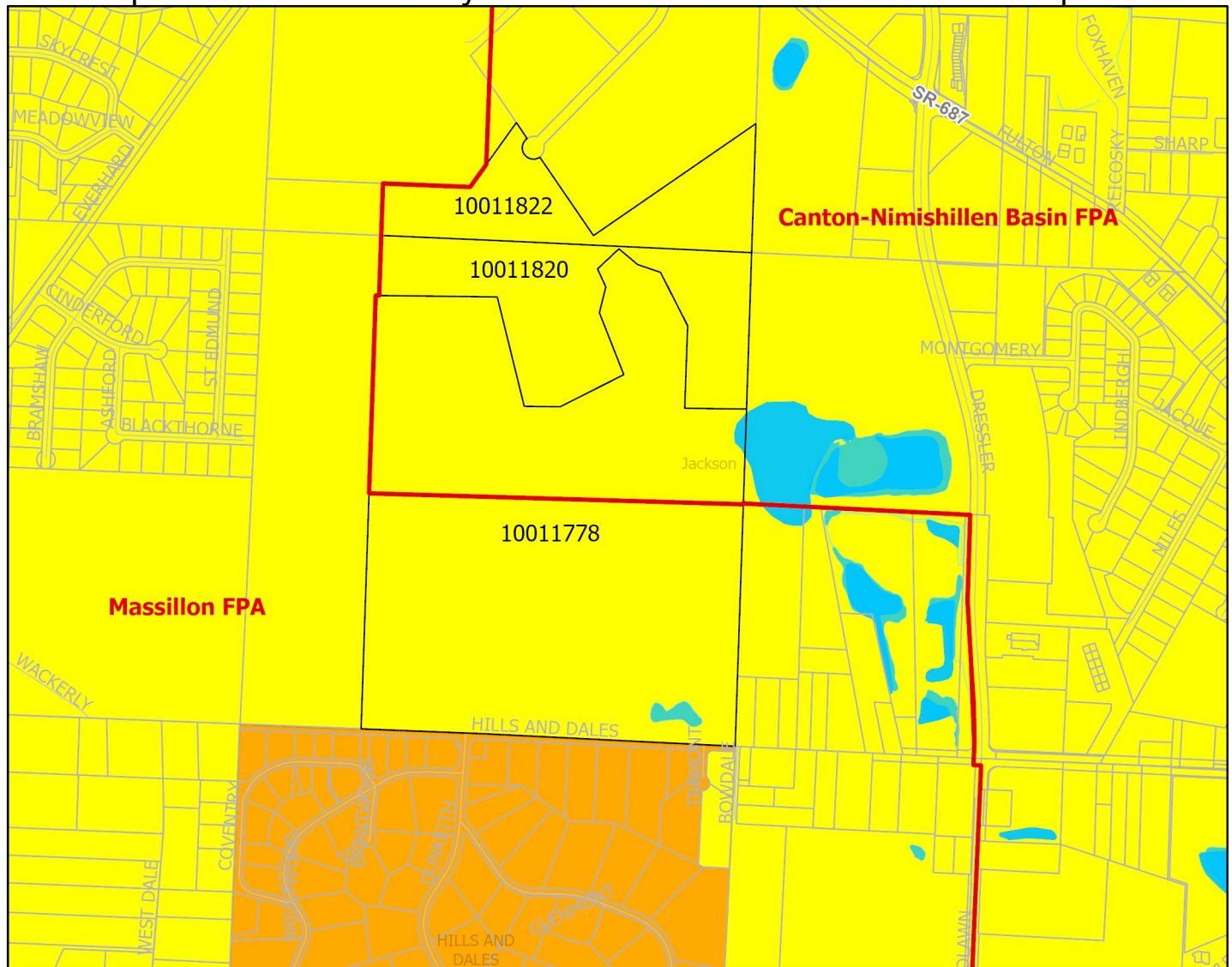

The Stark County Metropolitan Sewer District (SCMSD) is requesting an amendment to the Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA (Appendix 3-19) and Massillon FPA (Appendix 3-22) of the NEFCO Clean Water Plan. The proposed Schuring Park development project on Belden Greens Circle NW in Jackson Township is located within both the Massillon FPA and Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA. SCMSD's requested 208 Plan amendment through NEFCO will place parcels 10011822 and 10011820, and approximately the northern one-half of parcel 10011778 completely within the Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA, allowing an economical means of wastewater transmission and treatment at the Canton Water Reclamation Facility.

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

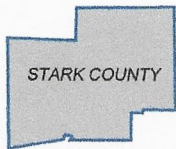

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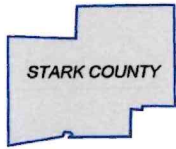

The Stark County Metropolitan Sewer District (SCMSD) is soliciting comments on a proposal to modify the boundary of the Massillon and Canton-Nimishillen Basin Facilities Planning Areas (FPAs) of the NEFCO Clean Water (208) Plan. The proposed Schuring Park development project on Belden Greens Circle NW in Jackson Township is located within both the Massillon FPA and Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA. SCMSD's requested 208 Plan amendment through NEFCO will place parcels 10011822 and 10011820, and approximately the northern one-half of parcel 10011778 completely within the Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA, allowing an economical means of wastewater transmission and treatment at the Canton Water Reclamation Facility.

The amendment will expand the Canton-Nimishillen Basin FPA boundary to include Schuring Park parcels 10011822 and 10011820, which are owned by Jackson Township, and to include approximately the northern one-half of parcel 10011778, which is owned by Stark Parks. It will redefine the Massillon FPA boundary to exclude Schuring Park parcels 10011822, and 10011820, and approximately the northern one-half of parcel 10011778. The 208 Plan's current wastewater treatment prescription for the amendment area is Areas Currently Served with Sanitary Sewer. There is no proposed change for that prescription.
