- Allowing LED and/or flashing lights for public safety signs only.

- Sandwich Board signs should be usable as temporary signage and must be located on private property.
- String light illumination used for signs or bright luminous lights that draw attention should be prohibited.
- City Manager Watson recommended to conduct a light pollution study.
