

New Buffalo Trash and Recycling Service Schedule

Weekly Trash Pickup:

Day: Every Wednesday.

**Residents are encouraged to place their trash containers at the curb the night before to ensure timely pickup.

Bi-Weekly Recycling Pickup:

Day: Every other Wednesday.

**Recycling should be sorted according to the accepted materials list and placed in the provided recycling toter.

Accepted Items for Recycling:

Please ensure items are empty, clean, and dry before placing them in the recycling toter.

Paper: Magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper, phone books, brochures, newspapers, **Cardboard:** Flattened cardboard boxes, paper bags, **Plastics:** Plastic jugs and bottles (#1 & #2), Household plastics (#3 - #7), **Metals:** Aluminum cans, steel & tin cans, **Glass:** Clear and colored glass bottles and jars.

Items Not Accepted in Recycling: 🚫

These items should not be placed in your recycling container.

Paper milk or juice cartons, Styrofoam containers/packing, Propane tanks, Paint or oil cans, Medical waste, Liquids of any kind, Plastic bags, Bubble wrap, Ribbons, and bows, Laminated or coated gift bags, Cellophane, Packing peanuts, Chemicals, Household cleansers, Garbage, Pizza boxes, Bagged film plastics.

Accepted Items for Trash:



General household waste excluding hazardous materials and those listed as not accepted.

Items Not Accepted in Trash: 🚫

Construction materials (e.g., concrete, bricks, stones), Batteries, Hazardous waste, Appliances, Electronic waste, Large furniture (without prior arrangement), Yard waste (requires special pickup), Any items that had/have Freon in them.

Special Notes:

- Holiday Schedule: Service may be delayed by one day following a holiday. Check the holiday schedule for specific adjustments.
- Bulk Items Pickup: Available upon request. Contact Lakeshore Recycling and Disposal at (269) 231-5623 OR by email at info@lakeshorerecycle.com for scheduling and fees.
- Yard Waste: Offered seasonally from April through October. Includes grass clippings, brush, and tree limbs up to 2 ft in length and 4 inches in diameter, which must be placed in a designated container or bio-bag.
