City Administrator Cabrales Jr. asked about June 8, 2024. Commissioner Burger said more volunteers are needed for the cleanup event. City Administrator Cabrales Jr. explained city staff would design a flyer. Commissioner Deborah Greene would like to see a regularly scheduled quarterly cleanup event. City Administrator Cabrales Jr. stated let's try to set a quarterly schedule.
