

<u>Operations</u> – After fixing our driveway, Jamie Wisdom, our Public Works Contractor, got out there and did some significant repairs to Martin Dale Lane, Justin Court and Pioneer Road to the Creek. We received 12 tons of road patch material called Super Pave recommended by Don Strange and Jamie has started filling potholes on HilltopTrail today. This amount should provide us a six-month supply. This product is supposed to hold up for at least 6 months and will buy us some time while we come up with a long term strategy for reconstruction.
