Operations –

Fairview Meadows Roads Update - The lime has been mixed in at about 36 pounds per square yard, remixed, and bladed to grade. Pavecon is in the process of putting down the compacted flex



base. Pavecon project superintendent Brandon Polvadore said Don Strange will get copies of the lab results and density tests as soon as he gets them from Alpha Testing. Weather permitting, he anticipates starting the hot mix process in the next ten days or so.



Over five inches of rain Saturday through Tuesday caused delays in the installation of additional culverts. Public Works has started patching potholes on Chisholm Hills Thursday.

Administration –

I have met with our city administrator finalist and he has tentatively accepted the position. I have provided him a draft contract which has been prepared with Cara White from the TCOASE law office.
