**Operations** –

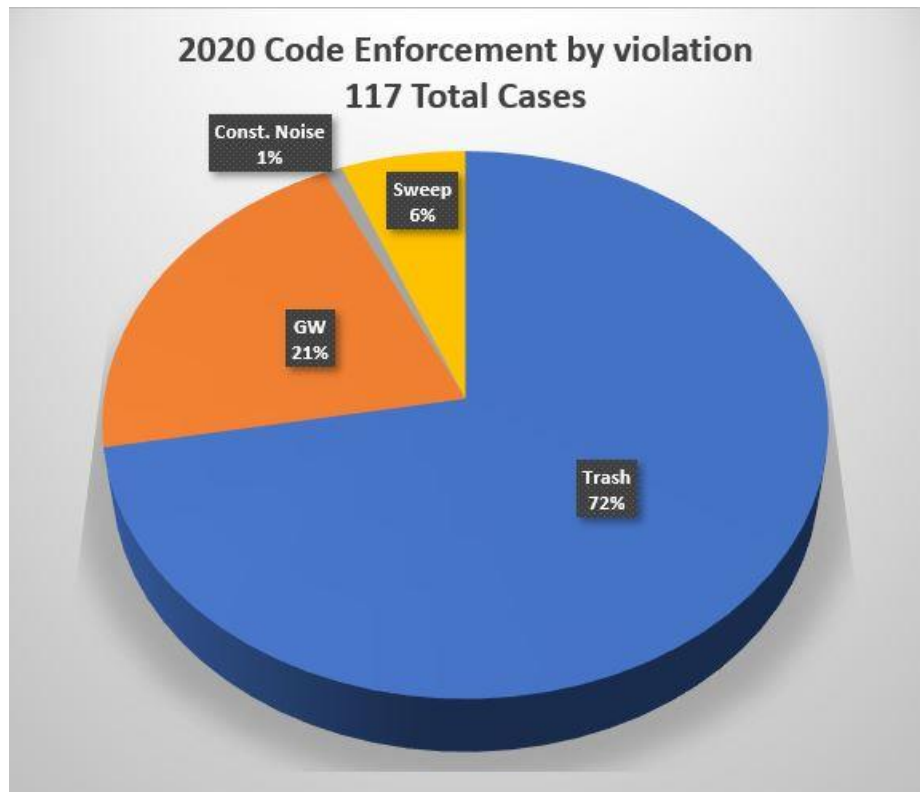
Public Works staff completed a considerable amount of pothole patching on Chisholm Hills over the past couple of weeks.



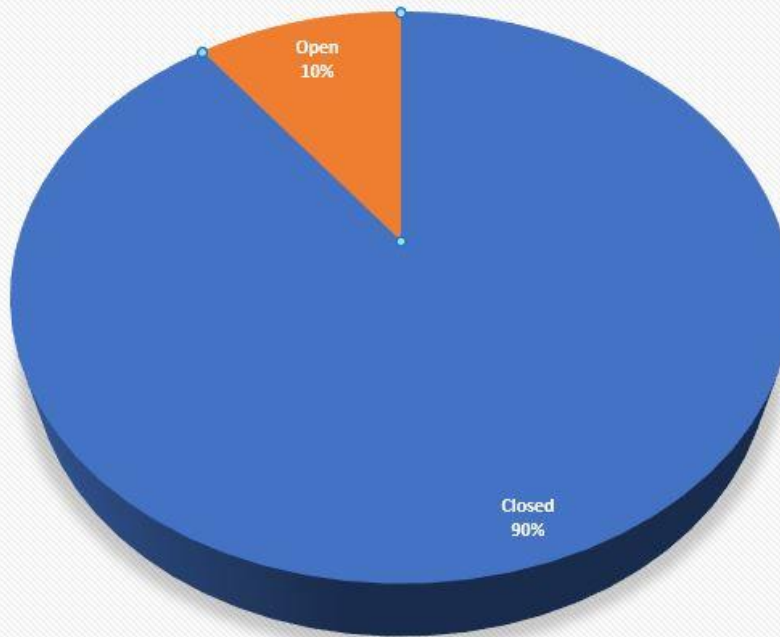


### **Code Enforcement**

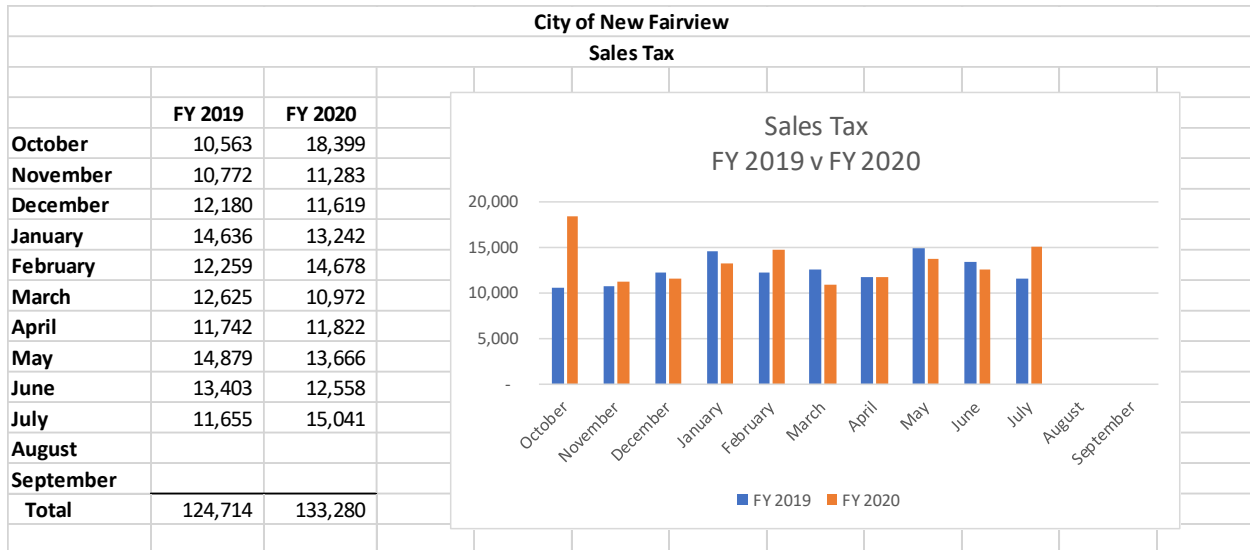

## Sales Tax

Sales tax was reported by the Texas State Comptroller’s Office for July for receipts received in the month of May. New Fairview received \$15,041, an increase of \$3,386, or 25.3%, over the same month last year. For the year sales tax totals \$133,280. This is \$8,567 more (6.9%) than through 10 months last fiscal year.



## Administration –

I have met with our city administrator finalist and he has tentatively accepted the position. He has agreed to the draft contract which has been prepared with Cara White from the TCOASE law office.
