4. **OPEN FORUM:** The City Council invites persons with comments or observations related to city issues, projects, or policies to briefly address the City Council. Anyone wishing to speak should sign-in with the City Secretary before the beginning of the City Council Meeting. In order to expedite the flow of business and to provide all citizens the opportunity to speak, there is a three-minute limitation on any person addressing the City Council. State law prohibits the City Council from discussing or taking action on any item not listed on the posted agenda.
5. **CONSENT ITEMS:** All matters listed as Consent Agenda are considered to be routine by the City Council and will be enacted by one motion. There will not be a separate discussion of these items. If discussion is desired, that item will be removed from the consent agenda and will be considered separately.

6. **NEW BUSINESS:** All matters listed as New Business will be discussed and considered separately.
- A. Conduct a public hearing on the adoption of impact fees. The purpose of the hearing is to consider the adoption of a transportation impact fee. The proposed impact fee per residential service unit is \$2,828.79. Any member of the public has the right to appear at the hearing and present evidence for or against the plan and proposed fee.
 - B. Discuss, consider and act on a resolution adopting the Transportation Impact Fees.
 - C. Discuss, consider, and select the Mayor Pro Tem by majority vote of the City Council from among its own membership; providing that the mayor pro tem's term is one year; providing that the mayor pro tem retains the right to vote on all matters before the Council while performing the duties of the mayor (Local Government Code Sections 22.037 and 23.027).
