ITEM NUMBER 7. NEW BUSINESS:

A. <u>Discuss</u>, <u>consider and act on Annexation Services Agreement related to the annexation by the City of New Fairview</u>, <u>Texas of approximately 140.246 acres of land situated in the James C. Jack Survey</u>, <u>Abstract No. 679</u>, <u>Denton County</u>, <u>Texas located on the southeast corner of the City- bordered on the north by Dove Hollow Lane and bordered on the west by South County Line Road</u>, <u>known as the Dove Hollow development</u>.

The property owner submitted a petition for the annexation of the property into the city on May 4, 2020. City Council held a public hearing on June 15, 2020. This annexation request has been reviewed by City Planner Barry Hudson. A service agreement will be made with Aqua Texas for water service. Mayor Pro Tem Johnson made a motion to approve the development agreement with Dove Hollow Annexation Service Agreement. Motion seconded by Councilman White. Motion passed unanimously.

B. <u>Discuss</u>, consider and act on Ordinance No. 2020-17-209 for the annexation by the <u>City of New Fairview</u>, Texas of approximately 140.246 acres of land situated in the <u>James C. Jack Survey</u>, Abstract No. 679, Denton County, Texas located on the southeast corner of the <u>City-bordered</u> on the north by Dove Hollow Lane and bordered on the west by South County Line Road, known as the <u>Dove Hollow development</u>.

City Attorney Bradley Anderle said everything legally has been done to move forward. Councilwoman McPherson made a motion to approve Ordinance 2020-17-209 for the annexation of Dove Hollow development. Motion seconded by Councilman White. Motion passed unanimously.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION INTO THE CITY OF NEW FAIRVIEW OF PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" AND DEPICTED ON EXHIBIT "B", LOCATED WITHIN THE CURRENT ETJ OF THE CITY OF NEW FAIRVIEW, TEXAS, FOR ALL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES; DIRECTING AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL MAPS; ESTABLISHING THE RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF INHABITANTS IN THE ANNEXED AREA; PROVIDING FOR FILING NOTICE OF THIS ANNEXATION IN DEED RECORDS OF DENTON COUNTY AND WITH THE WISE AND DENTON COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICTS; APPROVING A SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR SUCH TERRITORY; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR THE EXCLUSION OF AREAS EXCEPTED FROM ANNEXATION; PROVIDING FOR ENGROSSMENT AND ENROLLMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Jack Survey, Abstract No. 679, Denton County, Texas located on the southeast corner of the city-bordered on the north by Dove Hollow Lane and bordered on the west by South County Line Road-as Planned Development for Single-Family Residential.

Councilwoman McPherson made a motion to approve Ordinance 2020-18-210 including the roof pitch minimum change. Mayor Pro Tem Johnson seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW FAIRVIEW, TEXAS, AMENDING THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF NEW FAIRVIEW ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2010-01-149 BY DESIGNATING THE ZONING OF A PARCEL OF LAND BEING APPROXIMATELY 140.246 ACRES OF LAND IN THE JAMES C. JACK SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 679, DENTON COUNTY, TEXAS, BORDERED ON THE NORTH BY DOVE HOLLOW LANE AND ON THE WEST BY SOUTH COUNTY LINE ROAD, FROM UNZONED (EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION) TO PD - PLANNED DEVELOPMENT FOR SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
