Johnny Appleseed Street Tree Project

The Johnny Appleseed Street Tree Project began in 1976 in an effort to support the City of Oakwood's commitment to urban forestry and the environment. To date, this program has been responsible for planting over 3,021 trees. Below are the highlights of the program:

- Cost of the selected species are discounted 50% to Oakwood residents. Trees must be planted in the city right-of-way.
- Species of trees will be 1 3/4" in diameter and are excellent for planting.
- The areas of Oakwood that need trees the most, as determined by the City, will be given first priority.
- One tree will be allocated at the 50% discount for each approved property site.
- Tree specie selections are well suited for planting and most are resistant to disease.
- The tree will be guaranteed for one growing season by the nursery who plants it.

Applications are available at the Oakwood Community Center during business hours, Monday through Sunday. Once the application has been completed, please return it along with your payment to the Oakwood Community Center or mail the application to the:

Applications will be time-stamped upon receipt and are approved first according to need and then according to when the application was received. <u>Checks are to be made</u> <u>payable to the City of Oakwood-Johnny Appleseed Program</u> or by cash or credit card.

The application deadline is *Sunday*, *November 8*, 2020.

Mature Height:	80' - 100'
Rate of Growth:	Fast
Shape:	Vase shape at maturity
Leaves:	Large, glossy green leathery foliage
Fall Color:	Yellow
Flowers:	Yellow, fragrant
Comments:	A true American Elm, tolerant of harsh growing conditions, and an opportunity to replace a lost piece of American History.

'Green Vase' Japanese zelkova Zelkova serrata 'Green Vase'



Tree Characteristics:

Mature Height:	50' - 80'
Rate of Growth:	Medium
Shape:	Vase-shaped
Leaves:	Sharply serrated, dark green
Fall Color:	Yellow
Flowers:	Monoecious, not showy
Comments:	Well suited to residential streets, good foliage and growth habit.



Eastern Red Oak

<u>Quercus rubra borealis</u>



Tree Characteristics:

Mature Height:	Generally over 70'
Rate of Growth:	Medium
Shape:	Upright and rounded, broadens with age
Leaves:	Dark, glossy green
Fall Color:	Bright red to dull red
Fruit:	Acorns
Comments:	An attractive residential tree; no serious disease problems; higher water requirements necessary for establishment.



'Ivory Silk' Japanese Lilac <u>Syringa reticulata</u> <u>'Ivory Silk'</u>



Tree Characteristics:

25'
Medium
Upright and oval
Medium to dark green
Faded green to chartreuse brown
Creamy white inflorescences in early June
Virtually disease and pest free ornamental tree.



'Green Mountain' Sugar Maple <u>Acer saccharum</u> <u>'Green Mountain'</u>



Tree Characteristics:

Mature Height:	60' - 75'
Rate of Growth:	Medium
Shape:	Upright-oval
Leaves:	Medium to dark green
Fall Color:	Yellow, orange and red
Fruit:	Samaras
Flowers:	Insignificant flowers that emerge before leaf set
Comments:	Excellent shade tree for lawns, large areas and street trees.
