DECEMBER 9, 2019 COUNCIL MEETING

City Council met in public session on December 9, 2019. Here are the highlights.

Council meeting minutes were approved for the November 4 regular session and work session and November 18 work session and executive session.

STATUS REPORTS

- Report from Citizen Budget Review Committee: Budget Review Committee (BRC) Chair Dave Dickerson and Vice Chair Bill Frapwell commented on the Budget Review Committee's work and presented the BRC's endorsement of the 2020 Budget, and the \$3 increase in stormwater fees.
- Honoring Detective Jorge Del Rio: A video honoring Detective Del Rio was played during the meeting. After the video, Chief Alan Hill shared some comments about Detective Del Rio.
- Message from Principal Tim Badenhop: Mayor Bill Duncan read a letter from Principal Tim Badenhop recognizing the public safety department.
- Public Safety Officer Swear-in: Mayor Bill Duncan presided over an oath of office ceremony for PSO Kyle Sewert. Chief Hill assisted and made some comments on PSO Sewert's experience.
- Citizens Police Academy (CPA): Councilmember Rob Stephens read a letter from Oakwood resident Healy Jackson about her experiences attending the 2019 Citizens Police Academy. Chief Hill then shared some information about the 2019 CPA class.
- Traffic Enforcement: Mayor Duncan read a letter from Rabbi Nochum Mangel, Executive Director of the Chabad of Greater Dayton, and then presented Council's response to the ABLE report.

Fifteen Oakwood residents addressed City Council to express their opinion on traffic enforcement and perceptions of Oakwood.
