OAKWOOD, OHIO:

The city of Oakwood is reopening the five public facilities listed below effective Monday, June 1. These facilities have been closed to the public over the past eleven weeks as part of the City's steps in protecting the health, welfare and safety of the Oakwood community, the general public, and Oakwood employees. "Although these facilities will again be open, we encourage our citizens and businesses to continue doing as much city business as possible via email and telephone", said City Manager Norbert Klopsch.

- Oakwood Community Center (OCC) at 105 Patterson Road. Office hours are 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Thursday; 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Friday; 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday; and 12 p.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday. Gardner Pool is scheduled to open on Saturday, June 6. See city website at www.oakwoodohio.gov for details. The Health Center remains closed at this time, but plans are being made to reopen it soon. Classes, programs and activities at the OCC will resume slowly as permitted following updated health guidelines. - Oakwood Public Works Center at 210 Shafor Boulevard. Office hours are 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday – Friday. After hours, please contact the Public Safety Dispatcher at (937) 298-2122.
- Oakwood City Building at 30 Park Avenue. Office hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday – Friday. All staff phone numbers and e-mail addresses are readily available on the City website. After hours, please contact the Public Safety Dispatcher at (937) 298-2122.
- Oakwood Public Safety Building at 30 Park Avenue. The Public Safety Dispatcher is available 24-7. For emergencies, dial 911. For non-emergencies, dial (937) 298-2122. Public Safety Department staff phone numbers and e-mail addresses are readily available on the City website.
- Oakwood Dog Park. The dog park will reopen on June 1, but with social distancing requirements.

Playground equipment, splash pads, restrooms and drinking fountains at all city parks remain closed.
