#### AN ORDINANCE

BY: VICE MAYOR BYINGTON	NO. 4962
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TO AMEND SECTION I, 2022 ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 4947, AND ANY EXISTING SUPPLEMENTS THERETO, TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF:

1. AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF \$120,000 TO BE EXPENDED FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR ENGINEERING COSTS RELATED TO THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYSTEM EVALUATION AND MASTER PLAN PROJECT.

FOR THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022.

WHEREAS, there exist 17 signalized traffic intersections throughout Oakwood to control the flow of vehicular, pedestrian and cyclist traffic; and

WHEREAS, these 17 signalized intersections are a critically important component of the city transportation infrastructure and must be maintained on a regular basis and upgraded from time to time when various parts of the signal system infrastructure approach the end of their useful life;

WHEREAS, the 2022 annual budget document includes stated goals and objectives planned for the year, and one such goal and objective is to develop a multi-year plan for rebuilding the traffic signal system; and

WHEREAS, in developing the plan, a primary objective is to create the plan in a manner that maximizes the opportunity to leverage federal and state grant dollars to assist in what will be a multi-million dollar endeavor; and

WHEREAS, the city manager has determined that the best approach to developing the plan is to engage professional traffic engineering consultants that have experience and expertise in evaluating existing traffic signal systems, designing new systems, and in seeking and obtaining federal and state grant dollars; and

WHEREAS, this supplemental appropriation will authorize an additional amount of \$120,000 to be expended from the Capital Improvement Fund for engineering services relating to this capital improvement project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

#### SECTION I.

To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said city of Oakwood during the period commencing January 1, 2022 and ending December 31, 2022, the following revised sums shall be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, with added material in bold type and deleted material in strike-through type:

**Fund Appropriation** 

309 Capital Improvement Fund

#### \$1,191,250 \$1,311,250

#### SECTION II.

The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by this ordinance of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

#### SECTION III.

This ordinance, as an appropriation to meet current expenses of the City, takes effect immediately upon its passage as provided by Section 3.04 of the City Charter.

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THREE YEAR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS WITH THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, OAKWOOD LODGE NO. 107, REPRESENTING PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS AND LIEUTENANTS.
WHEREAS, representatives of the City and Oakwood FOP Lodge No. 107, which represents both public safety officers and lieutenants, discussed successor agreements to the current collective bargaining agreements, of which the public safety officer agreement expires on October 26, 2022, and the lieutenant agreement expires on November 3, 2022; and
WHEREAS, following discussions, representatives of the public safety officers and the City were able to agree on terms for a new three (3) year contract; and
WHEREAS, the lieutenants subsequently agreed to the same contract terms that were offered and agreed to by the public safety officers; and
WHEREAS, these separate collective bargaining agreements with Oakwood FOP Lodge No. 107 provide the public safety officers and lieutenants with responsible wage increases over the next three (3) years given the city's available financial resources; and
WHEREAS, the proposed agreements have been reviewed with Mayor Duncan and Vice Mayor Byington in their capacity as members of City Council's Finance Committee, and
WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends the execution of separate three (3) year collective bargaining agreements with the public safety officers and lieutenants, to expire on October 26, 2025 and November 3, 2025, respectively;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:
SECTION I.  The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute collective bargaining agreements with Oakwood FOP Lodge No. 107 as discussed, to wit: a three (3) year collective bargaining agreement relating to the public safety officers, to expire on October 26, 2025, and a three (3) year collective bargaining agreement relating to the public safety lieutenants, to expire on November 3, 2025.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22, Ohio Revised Code.

#### A RESOLUTION

BY: VICE MAYOR BYINGTON NO. 19
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A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A THREE-YEAR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION REPRESENTING THE PUBLIC SAFETY DISPATCHERS.

WHEREAS, in early August, representatives of the City and The Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, representing the dispatchers, discussed a successor agreement to the current collective bargaining agreement which will expire on November 3, 2022; and

WHEREAS, following discussions, the parties were able to agree on a new three (3) year collective bargaining agreement to become effective November 4, 2022; and

WHEREAS, this new collective bargaining agreement provides the public safety dispatchers with responsible wage increases over the next three (3) years given the city's available financial resources; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement has been reviewed with Mayor Duncan and Vice Mayor Byington in their capacity as members of City Council's Finance Committee, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends the execution of the three (3) year collective bargaining agreement covering the Public Safety Dispatchers, to expire on November 3, 2025;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

#### SECTION I.

The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a three (3) year collective bargaining agreement with The Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association to expire on November 3, 2025.
