The appropriation for contingencies can only be expended upon approval of three-fourths (3/4ths) vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the City, and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.

### SECTION III.

This annual appropriation ordinance shall become effective as of the first day of January, 2024, as provided by Section 6.05 of the City Charter.
