Dear Oakwood Resident,

In the February/March *Oakwood Scene* city newsletter, you will find an article about a large storm sewer improvement project planned for construction in 2023. We call it the Far Hills Storm Sewer Reconstruction. This stormwater infrastructure improvement project will take place on Far Hills Avenue at Greenmount Boulevard; on Dellwood Avenue between Far Hills Avenue and East Schantz Avenue; on Forrer Boulevard between Far Hills Avenue and East Schantz Avenue; and along a section of Devereux Drive north of Forrer Road.

We conducted an analysis of the existing storm sewer system in this area and found several sections of the system reaching the end of their useful life. Engineering design work for the project will begin in March with the first phase being a comprehensive land survey of the area. You can expect to see surveyors in your neighborhood from time to time as this work is performed. The survey work will generally be limited to the public rights-of-way along the sections of roadway mentioned above, and through utility easements, particularly in the area west of Greenmount Boulevard between Far Hills Avenue and Devereux Drive.
