Summary

Furthermore, the Instructor will report to the Youth Club Supervisor and Parks and Recreation Director.

Essential Job Functions

(The listed examples may not include all duties performed by the person in this position. Duties may vary from time to time and are at the discretion of the Planning/Code Enforcement Director.)

- Must be able to teach dance and cheer classes to groups of children between the ages 4-17.
- Engages, encourages, and motivates children to reach their goals.
- Develops dance/cheer curriculums and prepares lesson plans.
- Evaluates student performance and makes recommendations for improvement.
- Instructs students on healthy stretching, lifting, and jumping techniques.
- Choreograph routines and select music for recitals, shows, and concerts.
- Provides a fun, safe, and creative environment.
- Implements any changes to the dance/cheer routines as needed.
- Must always display professionalism when dealing with children and parents.
- Effectively communicates with parents and children of all ages.

Required Knowledge, skills, and Abilities

- **Must maintain a high level of ethical behavior.**
- Ability to communicate effectively with peers, supervisors, children, parents, and people.
- Must have reliable transportation.
- Must be a team player with a positive service oriented attitude.
- Ability to plan and implement quality dance/cheer programs for youth.
- Must be able to demonstrate patience and leadership skills.

Education and/or Experience

1. Experience in teaching or participation in dance and cheer in the past preferred.
