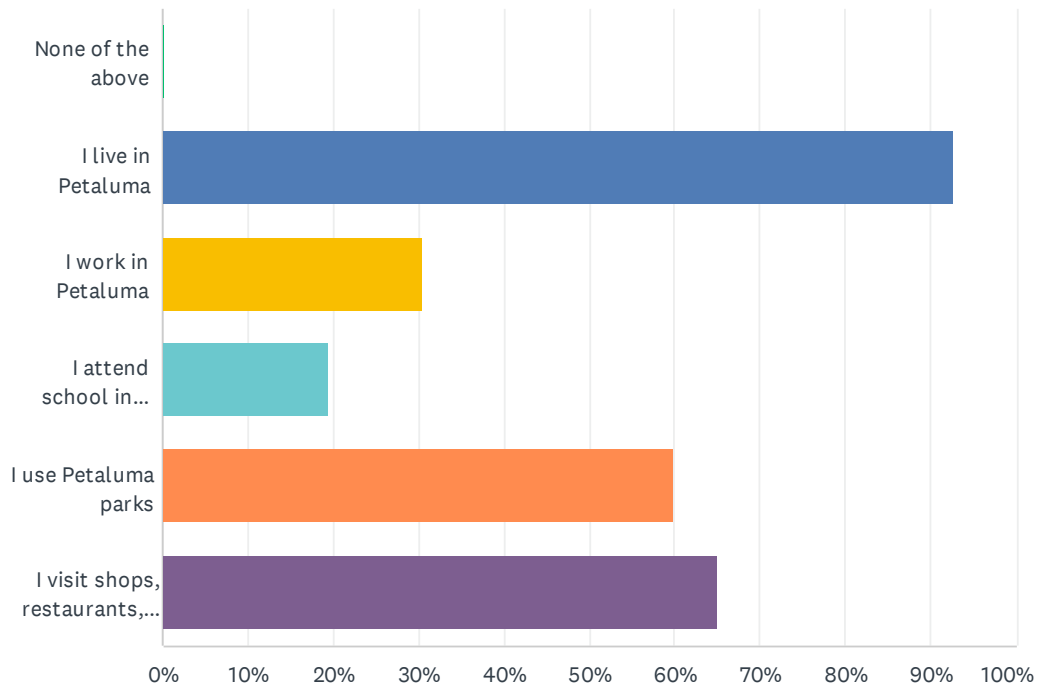


# Q1 Which of the following applies to you? Select all that apply.

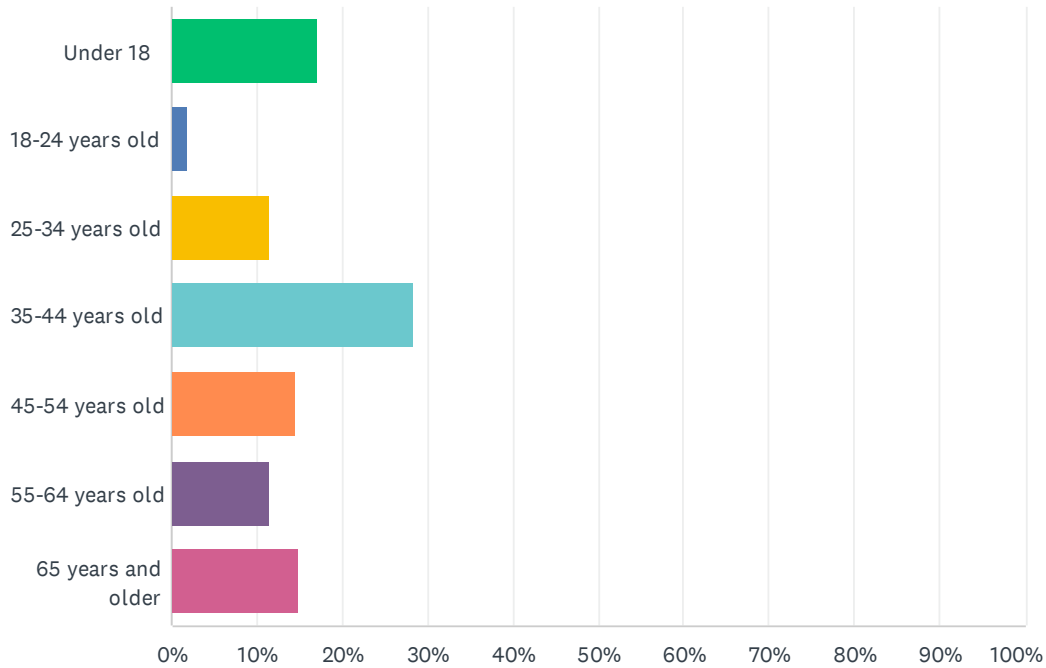

## Q2 What is your age?

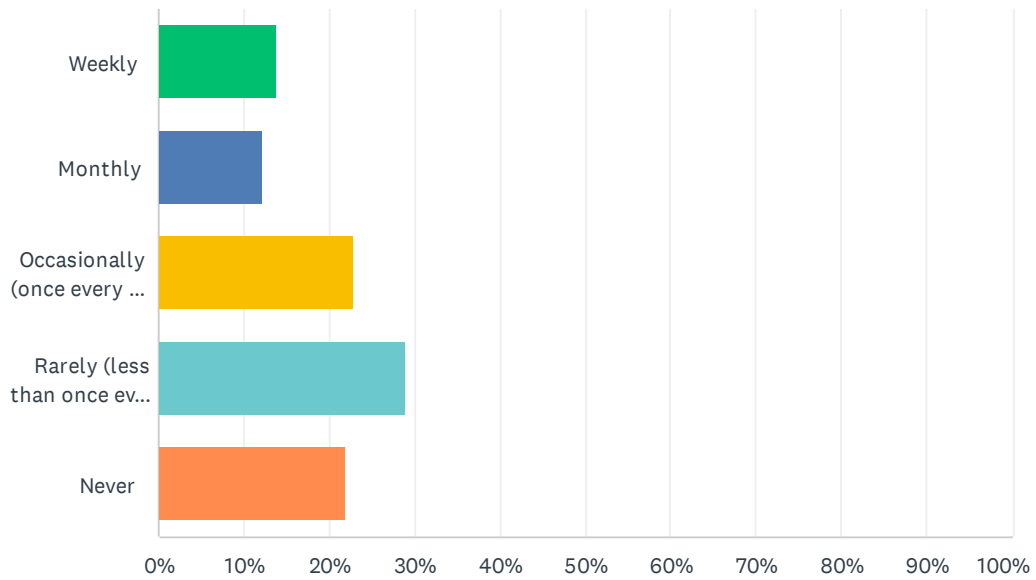

### Q3 How often do you visit Kenilworth Park?

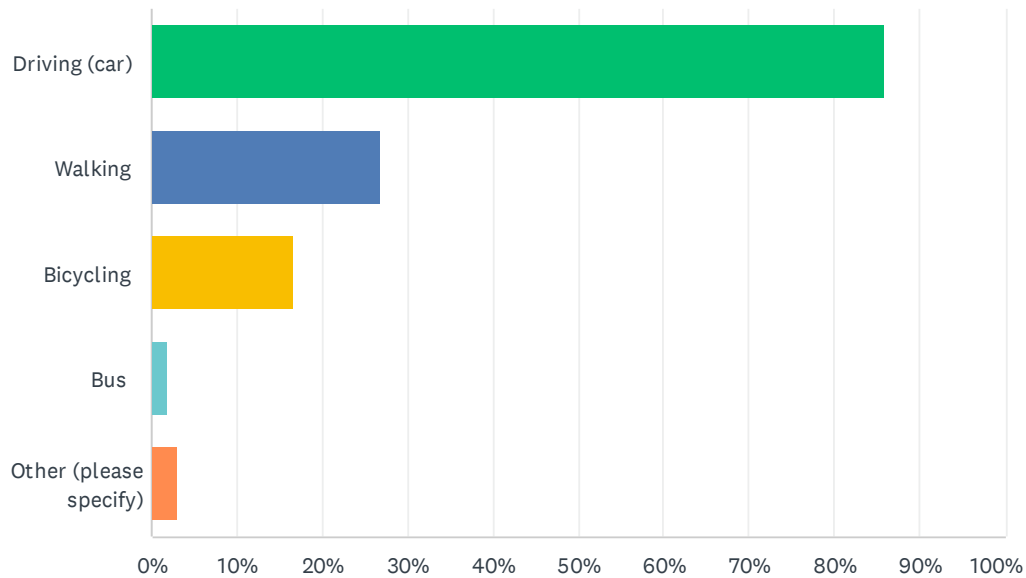
