ADDENDUM NO. 1

Transit Center Parking & ADA Improvements City Project No. C65102009

February 26, 2020

This Addendum No. 1 modifies the Bidding Documents for the Transit Center Parking & ADA Improvements project, City Project No. 65102009, and shall become part of the Contract Documents for this Project.

QUESTION AND ANSWER

Q: Will the City require public access to the property through the construction site? **A:** No. The contractor shall submit a Traffic Control Plan (TCP) which indicates how pedestrian traffic will be routed around the jobsite to the front gate of the Transit Center along McDowell Blvd. The TCP shall contain details regarding all appropriate delineation, barricades and signage required.

Q: Will temporary fencing be required?

A: Fencing will be required to limit public access in the construction zone. In addition, temporary fencing will be required for the demolition of the existing fence. Note: temporary fencing must maintain the same level of security as the current fence.

Q: What is to be done with the irrigation system within the project excavation area? **A:** Irrigation lines within the project area shall be removed and disposed of by the Contractor. The main irrigation line (which is anticipated to run from N. McDowell along Transit Way) shall be capped to the northwest side of the proposed concrete stairs. The Contractor shall expose this main line closest to the project area and discuss with the Engineer prior to cutting and capping.

Q: What is the plan for excess spoils produced during the project excavation? **A:** The project Engineer estimates that all excavated soil can be re-used on site by regrading the site. Excess soil can be disposed of at the Petaluma Airport. Access, and disposal location shall be coordinated with the City's project Engineer.

Q: Are there any Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements? A: DBE is encouraged but not required.

Q: What are the Transit Center main gate (along McDowell) hours? **A:** 7 AM to 6 PM

Comments: All utility boxes embedded in the sidewalk must be slip resistant.
