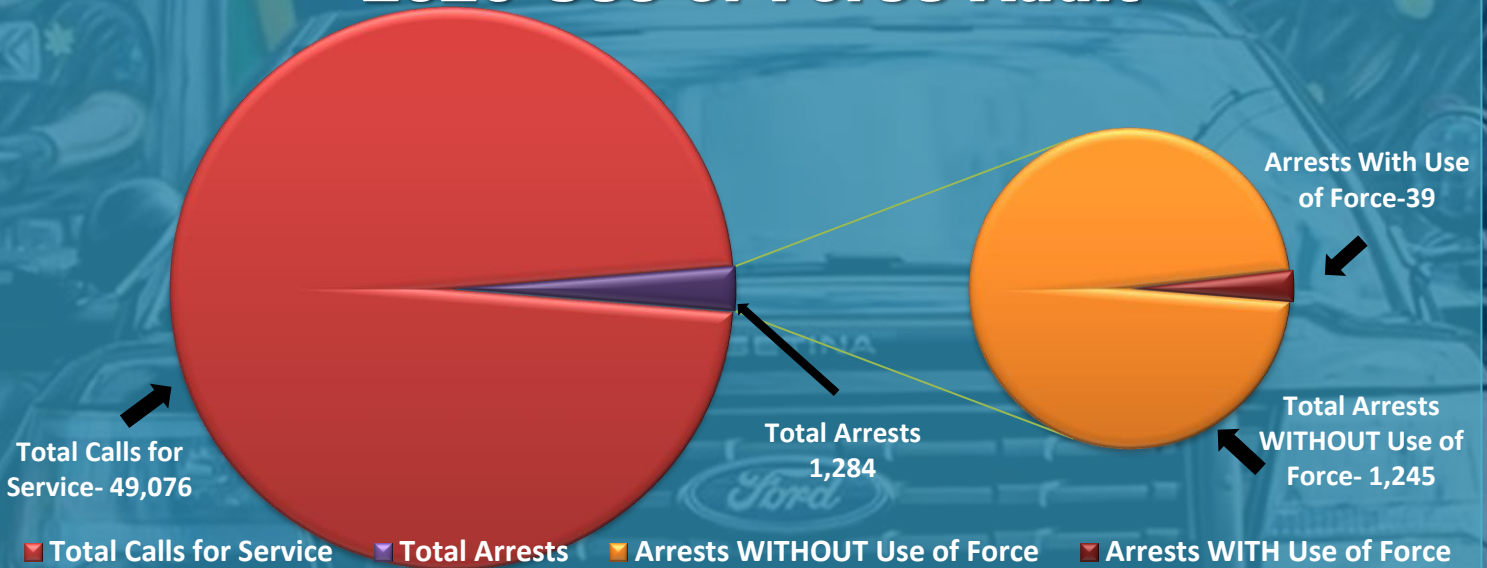

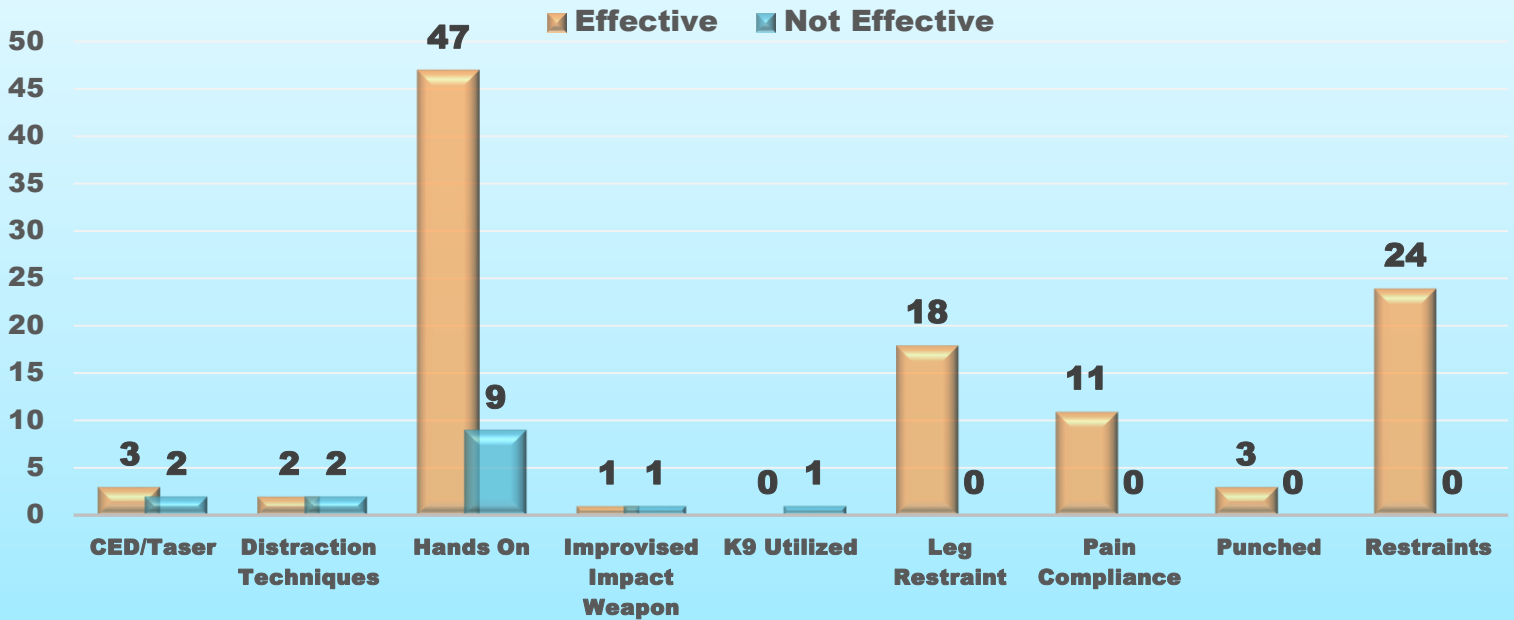

Types of Force Tally*



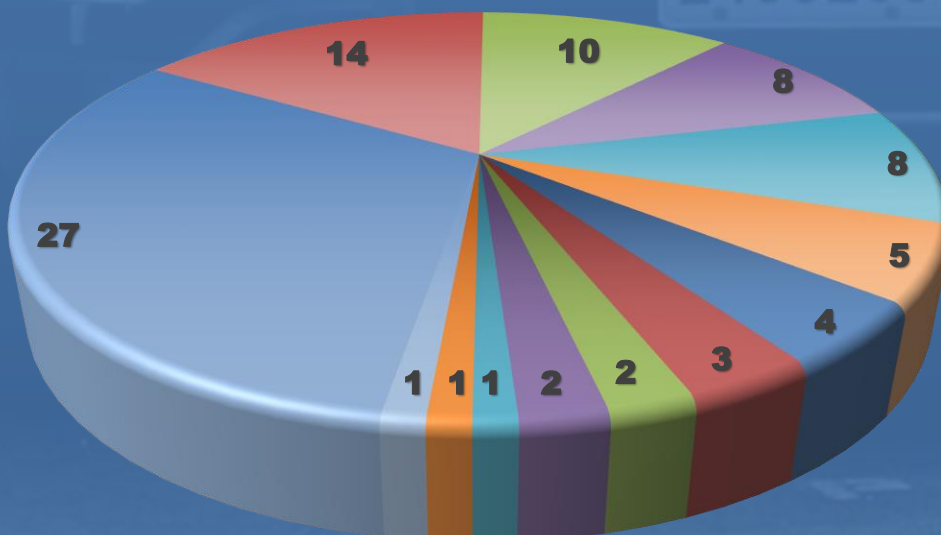

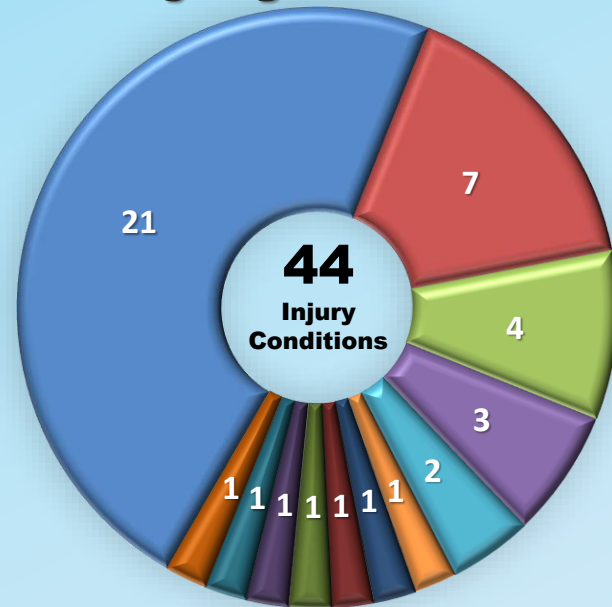

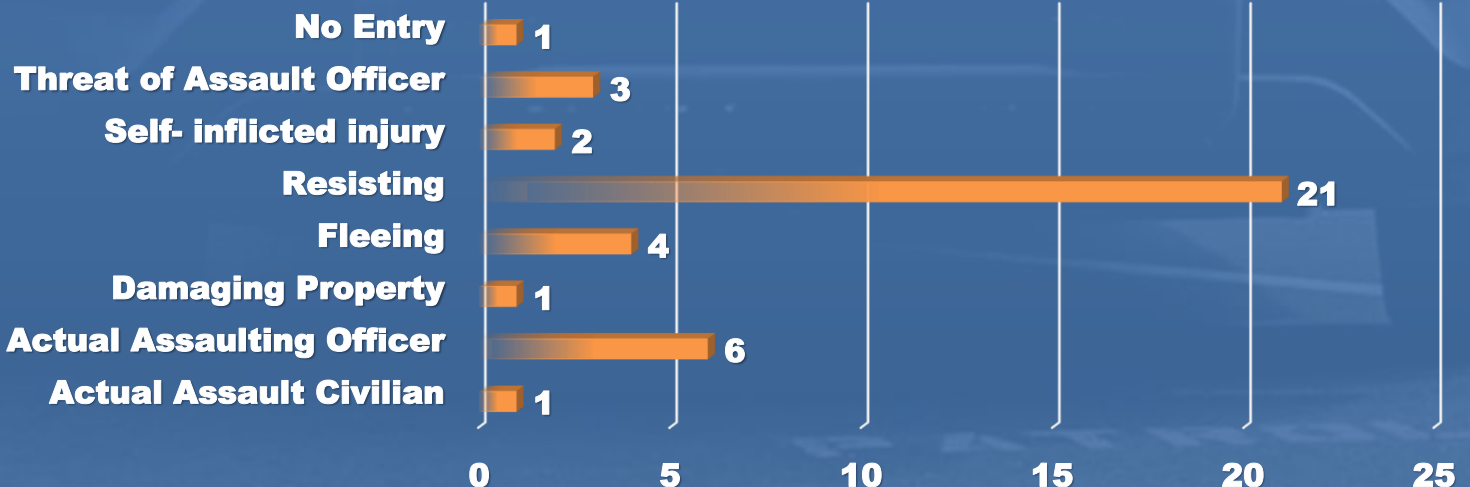

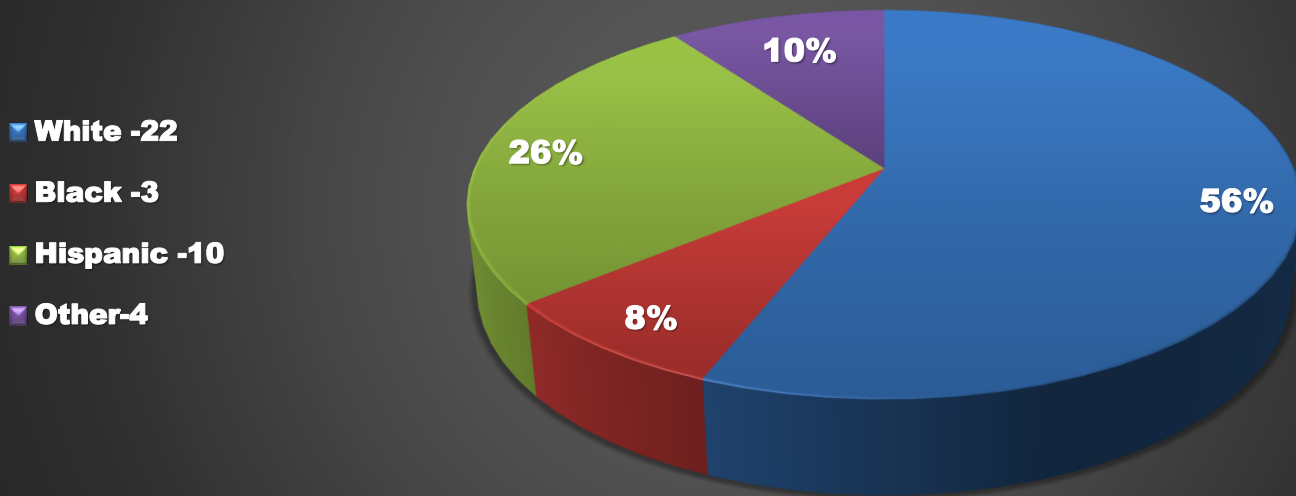
