

## **GUIDANCE FOR STATE COLOR TIER SYSTEM**

**RED TIER: SUBSTANTIAL** 

## What WILL Change

Sonoma County will be eligible to move into the Red Tier "Substantial" on California's Color Tier System Sunday, March 14, **2021.** The following will change once in the Red Tier:



Restaurants can operate indoors with 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer



Movie Theaters can operate indoors with 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer



Museums, Zoos, and Aquariums can operate indoors with 25% capacity



**Gyms** can operate indoors with 10% capacity



Retail stores (clothing, books, jewelry, etc.) may open at a maximum 50% capacity



Grocery stores may operate indoors at a 100% capacity

## What you NEED to know

- Where the State sets an indoor capacity percentage limit in the red tier, then the total indoor capacity can be determined by using the posted fire maximum capacity limit and ability of individuals from different households to be able to maintain social distancing. Where there is no posted fire maximum capacity limit, then contact vour local fire protection district.
- The County could move back into the Purple Tier if all three metrics (daily case rate, overall positivity rate, and health equity positivity rate) fall within the purple tier metric for two consecutive weeks.
- A county can only move forward one tier at a time, even if metrics qualify for a more advanced tier
- County of Sonoma is in alignment with State Public Health Orders, but may restrict County Public Health Orders if needed
