

HOW DOES PUBLIC ART GET FUNDING IN PETALUMA?



All funding for the Public Art Fund is generated from public and private development in the City of Petaluma.

Developers are required to provide publically accessible art equal to 1% of the overall construction cost.

Developers can meet this public art requirement in two different ways:



Work with an artist to develop an artwork

OR Pay the equivalent as an in-lieu fee



The money raised by this in-lieu fee goes into the Public Art Fund. With this money, the Petaluma Public Art Committee makes decisions to fund the following items as described in the Public Art Master Plan:

- Artwork acquisitions and commissions for public property
- Administration and outreach
- Maintenance and conservation of public art collection
