WATER STREET RIVERFRONT REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

The City of Petaluma Public Art Committee (PPAC) is reissuing this Request for Qualifications (RFQ) and is seeking qualifications from artists or artist teams for the commission and installation of site-specific, original, outdoor art for the Water Street riverfront area in downtown Petaluma. The intent of the project is to add a signature art installation along the Water Street corridor that enhances a sense of place associated with the riverfront area. A successful piece will integrate with existing landscape and structures, consider the area as whole, and take into account the history of the area and its cultural importance to the City of Petaluma. The piece should be inviting to pedestrian traffic from the downtown area, take into account the history and cultural importance of the area, and viewable day or night. An all-inclusive award amount of \$120,000 to \$150,000 for the artwork is projected.

The deadline for submissions is November 15, 2016, 5:00 p.m. (PST)
