FIX LEAKS

Place a bucket in your shower and use the captured water in your garden or around the house.



INSTALL HIGH-EFFICIENCY TOILETS

Installing high-efficiency toilets can save 19 gallons per person each day. Rebates available for high-efficiency toilets and clothes washers.



TAKE SHOWERS THAT ARE LESS THAN 5 MINS.

Reducing your shower from 8 mins. to less than 5 mins. can save 5.5 gallons of water per shower using a water-efficient showerhead.



INSTALL HIGH-EFFICIENCY AERATORS

Installing high-efficiency faucet aerators in your bathroom and kitchen can save up to 1.2 gallons per person per day.
