INSTRUCTIONS

- Please remain in your vehicle at all times unless instructed otherwise. Please follow police instructions at all times... Our instructions are for your personal safety and the safety of others.
- Do not handle any firearm(s) yourself. An officer will take control of your firearm(s) and safely remove the firearm(s) from your vehicle.

PLEASE PROVIDE THE OFFICER THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1. Number of firearm(s) are in your vehicle.
 2. The location of the firearm(s) within your Vehicle.
 3. Any knowledge as to whether any of the donated firearms are loaded. This information is essential. Our concern is safety for this event...not fault.
- Advise the officer if you have in your vehicle any other items which could be considered hazardous such as ammunition, gun powder, military ordnance items, fireworks, etc. Again...if present, the officer alone will handle and control these items for your safety.
 - At all times, please follow all traffic directions and lane controls and maintain safe distances from all other vehicles and pedestrians.
 - Please keep the donation receipt provided to you by the officers. Review the firearm number and types noted on your receipt and promptly bring to the attention of the officer(s) any perceived errors. Note: Your receipt is valid only at the date, time and location of this event and is required to receive your payment...do not lose your receipt.
 - Your personal information regarding your firearm's origin or activity, if voluntarily offered, will be kept confidential and will not be disclosed. This buyback event is administered as a "no questions asked" affair and you will not be subjected to any questions by attending police personnel.
