- Bike Boulevards recommended in City's *Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan* (2008)
- 5th Street Bike Boulevard concept was approved by City Council
- We will explore some design ideas with you tonight

Background

- Identified as low traffic alternative to Petaluma Blvd. S and 6th St.
- Included in Slow Streets Program
- Supports City Goals
 - Carbon Neutrality
 - Safe Streets & Active Transportation



Project Goals



"Neighborhood Greenways are slow, quiet streets, that prioritize people walking, bicycling, and rolling. They are the backbone of the Safe Routes to School network and connectors between neighborhoods, parks, schools, and business districts."

3 streets run between Downtown and Mt. View Avenue:



- 6th Street




















Design Options

- Signage & Lane Markings
- Speed Humps
- Curb Extensions / Bulbouts
- High Visibility Crosswalks
- Traffic Circles
- Stop Sign Removal on 5th Street
- Traffic Diverters













Signage & Lane Markings

- **Purpose:** Assist with wayfinding and clearly communicate street operations to all road users
- **Proposed Locations:**
 - Throughout project corridor





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Speed Humps

- **Purpose:** Slow traffic
- **Proposed Locations:**
 - Between E and F Streets
 - Between I Street and Mt. View Avenue (2)



Curb Extensions / Bulbouts

- **Purpose:** Slow traffic, and shorten pedestrian crossing distance, & improve sight distance
- **Proposed Locations:**
 - All intersections where feasible



High Visibility Crosswalks

- **Purpose:** Improve pedestrian safety and slow traffic
- **Proposed Locations:**
 - All intersections where feasible




Traffic Circles

- **Purpose:** Slow traffic and improve intersection safety
- **Proposed Locations:**
 - B Street, G Street, & I Street (if feasible)

Stop Sign Removal on 5th Street

- Purpose: Create a more efficient bicycling experience, improve predictability, and encourage more cautious driving across 5th Street
- **Proposed Locations:**
 - F Street
 - Anywhere a traffic circle is installed


Traffic Diverters

 - D Street




- Purpose: Prohibit drivers from crossing D Street or making left turns onto or off D Street while also providing a refuge island for people crossing on foot or bike

 - D Street




CIRCULATION IMPACTS: Southbound Left Turn




CIRCULATION IMPACTS: Northbound Left Turn
