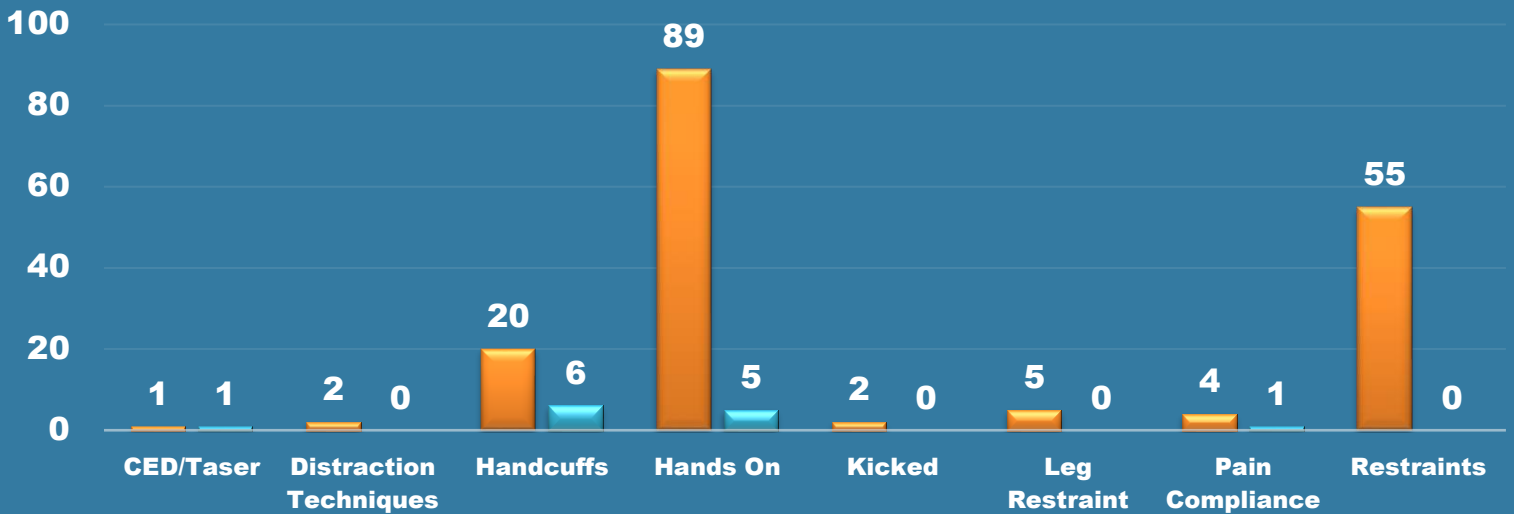

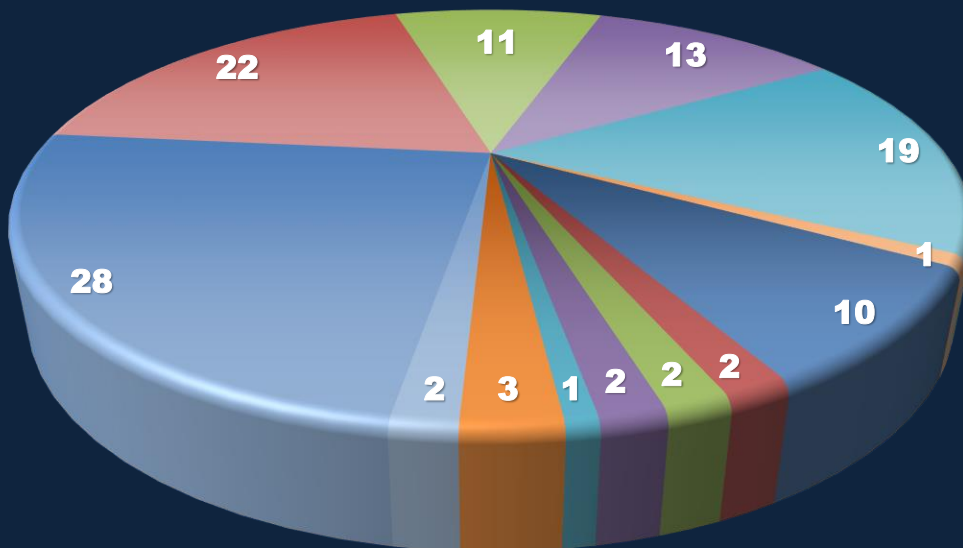

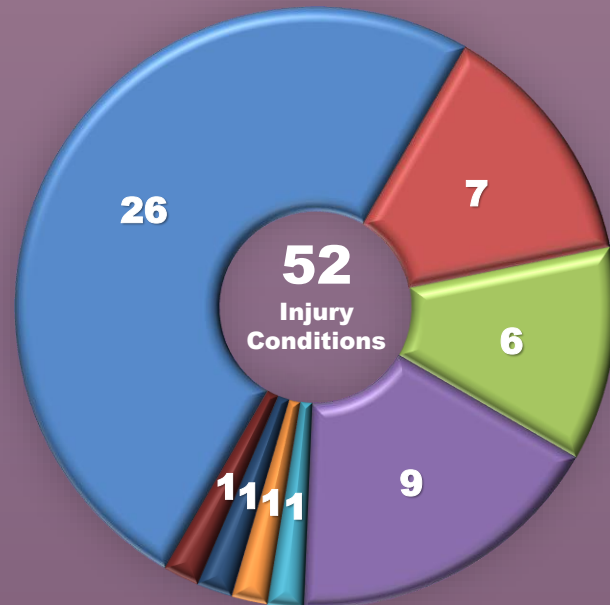

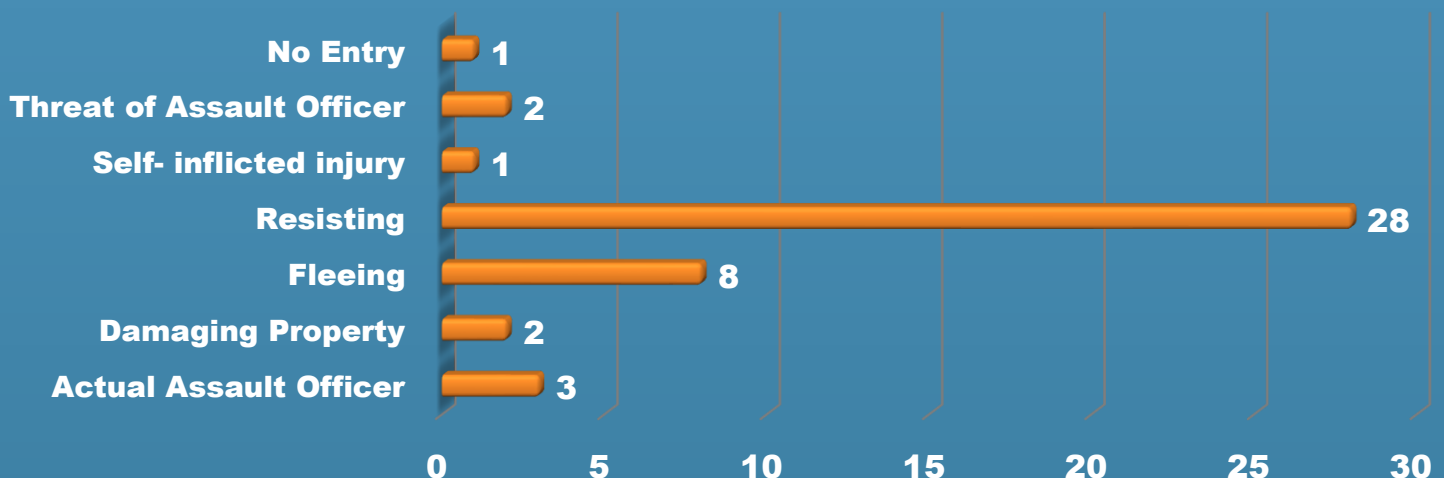

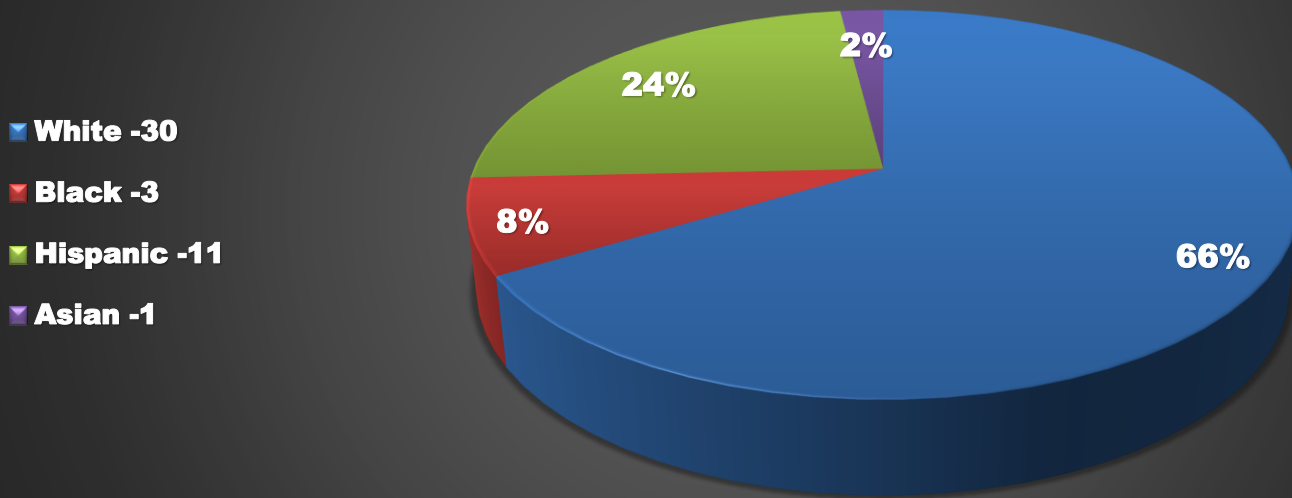


Reasons for Use of Force
