- Space between elements
- Flow bowls in the x-games with centerpiece/center island
- Phase 1 bowl
- Deeper bowl(s)
- Bigger stair drops
- Square and round rails
- Curbs
- 4' concrete tombstone mini ramp
- Change spine to bank for flip tricks (with deck).
- Separate pool bowl and flow bowl.
- Bowl doorway.
- Bowl channel.
- Flyout.

### Notes from Community Meeting #3

- Pier 7 ledge.
- Butterfly bowl.
- Kite in Phase 1.
- Creative ledges
- Pentagon (or pentagon) shaped bump (pyramid)
- Quarterpipes opposing bowl deep ends.
- Center island in bowl.
- Bank to wall.
- Bank wall.
- Pole Jam.
- Make the 3 stair a 4 stair and make the rail on the stairs a little bit smaller.
- Mini quarter pipe for beginners.

Other Considerations: Lights, Graffiti, Wall, Shade Structures, Trees, Connections, Art
