Drop-off & Pick-up

- Location:
 - Kinder Elementary School
536 Central Ave, Miamisburg, OH 45342
- Times:
 - Drop-off: 8:30am-8:45am
 - Pick-up: 3:30 pm
- You will need to provide identification for pick-up, please have your ID
- Only authorized contacts listed in ePACT are permitted to drop off & pick up campers
- The drive through ENTRANCE for drop-off & pick-up is from **Park Avenue**, south of Kinder Elementary. Parking is very limited, please plan to stay in your car. Staff will assist campers from vehicles into the building.
- The drive through EXIT for drop-off & pick-up is onto **E. Central Avenue**, north of Kinder Elementary.

**No parking is allowed in the drop-off/pick-up drive through.

Sycamore Trails Aquatic Center

- All camps, including themed camps, will visit Sycamore Trails Aquatic (STAC) center at least once a week, weather permitting.
- Every week, a swim test will be administered to all campers to enable staff to assess each child's swimming abilities. Based on the results of the swim test, children may or may not be restricted to specific areas of the facility. Participants must still abide by facility's policies on height restrictions.
- Parents will need to send with their child with a towel, swimsuit, flip flops or swim shoes and waterproof sunscreen.
- Changing areas are available at STAC. Campers do not need to wear bathing suits to camp.
- The campers can purchase concessions at the pool, so money may be sent with your child. We recommend that you do not send more than \$5 each day.

What to Bring

DAILY

- Sack lunch and drink (no Peanut Butter)
- Wear closed-toe shoes (gym shoes, no sandals)
- Rain gear (no umbrellas please; raincoats or jackets with hoods as necessary.)
- Sunscreen
- Water bottle
- Hat (optional)

SWIM DAYS

- All items on DAILY list
- Swimsuit
- Water shoes or sandals
- Towel

FIELD TRIP DAYS

- All items on DAILY list
- Wear Camp Tee
- Additional cash (optional, Miamisburg Day Camps are not responsible for lost funds)

What NOT to Bring

- Cell phones (campers will be required to leave cell phones in camp bag or book bag until the end of the day)
- Electronic devices or games
- Toys, playing cards and other personal belongings, unless otherwise noted



Camper Expectations

Practicing the 3 R's

At Miamisburg Camps we practice the 3 R's: Respectful, Responsible, Ready. Campers should be respectful of others and their equipment, responsible for their actions and their belongings, and ready to participate and listen to instructors. The 3 R's is an easy way for campers to remember the Parks & Recreation expectations.

Campers are expected to:

- Take responsibility for their own behavior
- Be courteous
- Be respectful of others and their property
- Cooperate with others
- Speak appropriately
- Seek alternatives to verbal and physical conflicts
- Exhibit self-control

Miamisburg Parks & Recreation is committed to ensuring a safe, nurturing and fun environment for all its campers.

Behavior policies are enforced in a fair and consistent manner. Individuals may lose the opportunity to participate in programs and services if these expectations are not met.




Illness/Sick Policy

- If your child has a fever, is vomiting, has diarrhea, or any other contagious illnesses please do not send them until they are free from symptoms for 24 hours. If a child develops these symptoms while at camp, parents/guardians will be contacted and expected to arrange pick up of the child.



Medications

- If your child needs any medications dispensed throughout the course of the day including Tylenol or Advil, it must be kept with the Camp Staff.
 - The Medical Waiver and Release section of ePACT must be completed with specific instructions regarding the medication.
 - Camp staff may not administer medication to campers. Staff are responsible for proper storage of medication and ensuring campers have access to it when they need it, but the camper must administer their medication themselves.
 - Please personally deliver all medications to camp staff directly.
 - All medications must be clearly marked with prescribed name and in original packaging.
