

City of Port Orchard Alarm System Registration

9.22.010 Telephone number of person authorized to turn off of reset alarm.

It is an infraction to have or maintain on any premises within the city any type of burglary, robbery, or fire alarm or alarm system unless there is on file with the city of Port Orchard Police Department a notice of the telephone numbers of at least two persons authorized to enter such premises and turn off such alarm and who can be reached at all times. It is an infraction for any person to fail to appear and turn off any such alarm within one hour after being notified by the Port Orchard Police Department to do so. (Ord. 1797 § 3, 2000).
